### A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR ANDY

#### A SUMMER OF CONNECTION

Here is a truth about me: I desire to be connected to everyone who is part of our church family! That's how I'm uniquely wired. I believe my God given passion is to connect with others! It's one of the reasons I work hard to get To know you by name. Knowing someone's name is a great first step to connect with them.

Despite my passion and desire to be connected to everyone in our church, I've had to come to terms with the reality that it is impossible for me to have deep, meaningful connections with each of our 500+ members, let alone everyone new to our church! Therefore, over my years in pastoral ministry, I've developed this strategy. Yes, I'm letting you in on a little secret. Although I really do want to be connected with you, I'm more passionate about making sure you are connected first to Jesus, and second, to at least a few other people in our church. So, here's what I try to do: 1) Get to know your name and a little bit about you 2) Make sure our staff are also generally aware of who you are so together we can 3) Help you get connected to others to develop friendships, grow in discipleship, and serve in mission and ministry.

Earlier this spring, our staff team decided to try and make the summer months a time to foster connection within our church family. We felt it was especially important to provide opportunities for our church family to be together and develop relationships with at least a few others. We know that if you don't have friends who care about you within your church family that it's easy to fade away, and we don't want that to happen to anyone! We want you to develop meaningful relationships with at least a few other people in the church. That's what makes us feel like family!

So, this summer we invited you to be part of a Dinner Group. Over 60 adults, in groups of about 8 each, have been sharing monthly dinners together! I'm excited to see how new bonds are created as a result. It was also a joy to witness so many people visiting at Pastor Kurt's retirement cookout in May, and younger folks getting connected through VBS and youth outings in June. And in case you're feeling sad thinking, "Well, I missed out on those opportunities..." let me highlight one more opportunity this summer to casually meet some other people in the church and simply have fun together. Check out the next page for details on our upcoming Gateway Grizzlies' night on Sunday, July 30. Buy tickets from the church office for yourself, your family, and maybe a friend you've wanted to invite to church. Come to the game and enjoy the atmosphere but look at it as a time for you to be intentional about meeting some new people.

Here's another secret: We're not having a Grizzlies' Night because we want you to watch a ball game. We're doing it to help you get connected and to foster relationships, old and new. We want to have fun together (and I plan on having lots of fun at the ball park!) because we know that if we can laugh and have fun together, then that makes it more likely that you will feel safe to join a journey group, band, or ministry team where you get connected to God and to others in ways that could be life-changing. So, I hope you'll take advantage of this opportunity (or others) to get connected this summer at Troy Methodist Church!



#### MIDDLE SCHOOL MISSION TRIP RECAP

For years my sons had gone to Midwest Mission in Chatham, IL with Troy Methodist Church. They would always say they had fun and I knew they were safe, but it wasn't until a week ago that I really got to see what goes on there. It is nothing short of life-changing!

My dear sons never explained to me that this ministry has world-wide impact. The warehouse is mind-blowing! When I walked in the doors and saw the desks that will be shipped to Ghana; with the precision that goes into constructing each one, I knew that there was something special about this place. I was with a team that put together cleaning kits for UMCOR. When we finished a pallet we prayed over it. We also prayed when we finished the school kits and personal care kits. That


was my favorite thing about all the work we did. My second favorite thing was that nothing gets wasted. Every bag, every deodorant that was too big for the kit, even used billboard signs, they all were put in a "redirect" pile. The used billboard signs are used as tarps to cover roofs that are damaged by storms.

I am so thankful that I got to experience Midwest Mission firsthand. Our youth team played card games in the dorm; we sang and had devotions. We bonded in a way that only happens when God hosts. It was hard work, good food, and lots of fun!

# CONGRATULATIONS TO RYAN AND COURTNEY FROIDCOEUR


