

The people have spoken! Thank you for sharing your feedback through email and in-person on Easter Sunday. We heard from over 400 of you! You overwhelmingly chose Troy Methodist Church as our new name. It was clear that you wanted to keep "Troy" in our name (over 80%) and you preferred "Troy Methodist" over "Troy Global Methodist" at about a 2-1 ratio. Despite "Global" not being in our name, we will use the Global Methodist Church logo and color scheme in all our branding. Furthermore, our rebranding team and church council felt it would be beneficial to have the tagline "A Global Methodist Congregation" to be used when appropriate. We are excited to be a Global Methodist Church beginning Sunday, May 7!

A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR ANDY

WE ARE EASTER PEOPLE

God's Spirit breathed new life into me on Easter Sunday. How about you? It was such a joy to celebrate Jesus' resurrection with 720 of you in person and over 300 of you online! As we sang together in each of our three worship services, my heart couldn't contain my love for God and love for each of you. At one point during our 9:00 service in the jam-packed sanctuary, I thought to myself, "Andy, how are you going to preach? You're a mess!" For me it was a little taste of heaven. I hope it was for you too. My soul needed it!

We have seen a growing momentum over the last two months. In the seven Sundays between the end of February and Easter Sunday we welcomed over 400 people in-person for worship as many times (5) as we did all of 2022, including all the weeks we offered four services last year! There has been a tangible move of God's Spirit in our midst that I do not take for granted. You have felt it too! I pray that continues as we move into the future as Easter people – resurrection people – people who have been given new life in Christ!



Part of that new life for our church will transpire this month. On May 6, we expect our Annual Conference to approve our disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church. That means that Sunday, May 7 we will worship together for the first time as members of the Global Methodist Church. I hope you will join us for our new series when we'll discover what it means to be GMC. In the meantime, please pray for that Annual Conference session on May 6 to go smoothly. We anticipate it will, but there have been occurrences in other conferences where some churches were not approved. That has led to long legal battles and ugliness that both we and our conference leadership hope to avoid.

We also are experiencing new life amongst our staff. We are in a time of transition as we celebrate and say goodbye to some and welcoming others. Please pray for our staff team, old and new, as we move forward with excitement and simultaneously thank God for the past.

Please know that I am praying for you. I pray that you are experiencing rebirth as God breathes new life into the parts of you that have been dormant, dry, or dead. That's what our God does! That's why we are Easter people!




CARE NOTES FROM PASTOR DAN

- Through worship., music, crafts, activities, games, lessons, mission and STEM we help kids learn they can and should follow Jesus here, there and everywhere!



New Life Student Ministry Day Trip to see uniquely beautiful places in Southern Illinois! **RSVP +\$50** Saturday, May 6, 2023 6:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.

All middle school and high school students are invited to make this special trip.

We will paddle canoes through the Lower Cache River, North America's northern most cypress and tupelo swamp – it is unusual and amazingly beautiful! It has been called 'floating forest,' many of the trees are 1,000 years old, and the Illinois state champion cypress tree is in this swamp. Note: there are no alligators in this swamp! Next, we will travel to Inspiration Point at the Larue - Pine Hills National Natural Landmark in Shawnee National Forest. The massive 150' limestone bluffs are impressive, even to the explorers Lewis & Clark in 1804. Our third stop of the day will be Bald Knob Cross – an awe-inspiring spiritual monument "where people can unite to experience the presence of God." We wrap up the day with some hiking trails in Giant City State Park and enjoying a delicious fried chicken family-style dinner. 
HELP US CELEBRATE THIS GUY...KURT'S RETIREMENT PICNIC!
