# Opening Activity

### 1 What You Do

Pray for your group before they arrive → Pray for kids who will visit your group for the first time. Thank God for reminding you that even kids make choices that matter. Ask God to help your group see how their words, actions, and even their attitudes can lead them closer to You. Pray that your small group environment is a space where kids feel safe to learn, make mistakes, and grow in wisdom. Ask God to give you gentle words and creative ways to help them understand that being wise starts right now!

- 1. Welcome kids to group with a high five or fist bump!
- Invite any kids who brought an offering to place it in the offering container.
- 3. Before you begin, place the "A" and "B" buckets at the front of your group area.
- 4. Mark a line with tape on the opposite end of your group area.
- 5. Give each kid six tickets from the "Ticket Toss" Activity Pages.

#### **Play Together**

- 1. Direct the kids to gather behind the tape line.
  - → They don't have to stand in a line!
- 2. Explain that you will read a "Would You Rather" question, and each kid will travel to place their ticket into the "A" or "B" bucket to cast their vote.
- 3. After each vote, give kids a moment to travel back to the other side of your group area.
- 4. Ask a few kids to share why they made their choice.
- 5. Repeat the process until all questions have been answered.

## ② What You Say

"That was so fun! Those were some silly choices. But you know what? They reminded me of the choices we have to make every day. Sometimes our choices can feel small or big. And sometimes, our choices make a big impact on our lives and on others!

"Today, we'll hear a true story from the Bible about different people who had to make important decisions, and what they chose shows us that choosing wisely matters. Let's go!"

## Inclusive Pro Tips

Be sure to demonstrate each step slowly!

### (1) What You Do

- 1. Gather the kids together on the floor or around a table.
- 2. Give every kid one zip-top bag, one paper towel, and 2-3 lima beans.

#### **Explore Together:**

- Say, "Today we're going to plant something—follow me step-bystep!"
  - → Step 1: Dampen the paper towel using the small water bottle. (Not too much! Assist the kids with this step as needed.)
  - → Step 2: Place the damp paper towel in the zip-top bag.
  - → Step 3: Add 2-3 lima beans on top of the towel, inside the bag.
  - → Step 4: Seal the bag tightly, leaving a bit of air inside.
- 2. Set out the permanent markers and instruct the kids to write their names, and "Be wise because your choices matter" on the bag.
- Say, "Over time, the lima beans will sprout and grow into little plants! Tape your bag to a window at home, where it can get some sunlight."
  - → Note: Let the kids know they will need to check on the beans each day, keeping the paper towel wet (but not too wet)!

#### **Talk Together:**

- Ask: "What happened when the kings made wise choices. What happened when they didn't?" (When kings made wise choices—like King Solomon during the season of his life when he asked God for wisdom and followed it—things went well for the people, and God was with them. When kings disobeyed God or made selfish choices, things got very hard. People stopped trusting God. Some kings even led the people to worship false gods, and that caused BIG trouble."
- 2. Ask, "What do you think made a king wise in God's eyes?"
- Ask, "Do you think it was always easy for the kings to choose what's right?"

## ② What You Say

"Today's Bible Story showed us ups and downs of kings who had choices to make. Some chose to follow God and God's ways, and the people they reigned over were blessed! Other kings didn't, and it caused a lot of trouble. God's way is always the best way to live.

"I want you to think of your beans like the choices we make. When we ask God for wisdom, and make the wise choice over and over again, it grows good fruit just like the seed turning into a strong plant. Does God give us grace when we don't make wise choices all of the time? Absolutely! That's why He sent Jesus—God knew we wouldn't get it all right all the time. But He wants to help us choose wisely and live well. That's part of the reason why He came to live inside of us Himself through the Holy Spirit, He wants to guide us through life well, so we live strong and beautifully!

"Sometimes, choosing God's way is not easy. But when we choose God's way over and over again, we grow into people who love well, live with purpose, and show others who Jesus is. Be wise because your choices matter."

Make It Personal → Share an age-appropriate time you had to make a big decision, and you decided to apply God's wisdom. Was it a verse you remember, or a conversation with a friend who followed Jesus that helped you? Share how seeking God first changed your situation.

## Inclusive Pro Tips



If it works better for your group, allow them to act out the cause/effect scenes instead of matching them on the paper.

### 1 What You Do

- Gather the kids together in a seated circle or at a table in your group area
- 2. Give every kid a "Cause and Effect" Activity Page and a pencil.

#### **Imagine Together:**

- 1. Invite the kids to form groups of 2-3.
- Say, "We're going to do an activity together to help us think about how our choices lead to different outcomes! On one side of your page, you'll see causes, things someone might do (point to them). On the other side, you'll see effects, what might happen next (point to them)"
- 3. Instruct the kids to work together to draw lines from each cause to its possible effect.
- 4. Refer to your copy of the "Cause and Effect" Activity Page, and, one by one, talk through each of their choices as a group!

#### **Talk Together:**

- Ask, "Can you think of a time you made a wise choice and it led to something good?"
- Ask, "What are some ways we can practice listening to the Holy Spirit in everyday life? Like at school, with our friends, or at home?" (Pausing before reacting, asking God for help in the moment, and reading the Bible to learn God's voice.)

## ② What You Say

"Great thinking, friends! Our choices matter. They matter because they shape our lives and the lives of others. The choices we make can lead to all kinds of outcomes—some good, some not-so-great. That's why today's bottom line is SO important: Be wise because your choices matter!

"Wisdom can mean stopping to ask: 'Hmm. God, what might happen if I do this?' He wants to help you make the wise choice! When we choose to follow Jesus, God's Son, we aren't on our own to figure things out—we have the Holy Spirit to guide us! The Holy Spirit helps us stop, think, and make decisions that honor God.

"What are some of these wise, godly choices we can make? Well, we can look at the life of Jesus to know what's wise! He is God and He showed us how God would live. Jesus didn't just tell people what was right. He lived it! He was kind. He was honest. He was fair. He was forgiving. He listened. He helped people who needed help.

"As we try to live wisely, we won't be perfect, but we'll grow in God's wisdom as we keep asking for it and practicing, even when it's hard. This week before you react, pause and remind yourself to be wise because your choices matter!"

#### **Inclusive Pro Tips**

If it suits your group better, prepare two sets of cups with the words from Proverbs 16:16 on them.

### (1) What You Do

- 1. Before you begin, use floor tape to mark two starting lines on one end of your group space.
- 2. Divide the kids into two teams and have them stand behind each line.
- 3. Place a stack of 19 cups a few feet away (for the NIrV, 15 for the NIV) from each starting line.
- 4. Give each team one permanent marker, and one Bible.
- 5. Direct the teams to look up Proverbs 16:16.
- 6. Repeat the verse together several times.
- 7. Review any words in the verse that might be unfamiliar to the kids.

#### **Move Together:**

- Show the kids the "Cup Stack" Activity Page and say, "Are you ready for a verse relay? One at a time, you will each race to:
  - → Grab one cup from the stack.
  - → Bring it back to your group.
  - → And use the marker to write one word from Proverbs 16:16 on it!
  - → Once the word is written, the next kid can go!"
- Say: "After your team has written all the words, you'll work together to make a cup pyramid with the verse in order. When your team is done, shout, 'PROVERBS 16:16!"
- 3. At your signal, begin the game!
- 4. Once a team has collected all of their cups and written on them, give them a "Cup Stack" Activity Page to follow to build their pyramid.
- 5. Play until both teams have stacked the verse words in correct order.

#### \*Finding verses with 2nd-3rd graders

## What You Say

"That was so fun! It took some focus to place those cups in just the right order. It also takes focus to build our lives on God's wisdom too.

"I love that we can trust the Bible because it's God's true Word. The King of all gave it to us. Every word helps us know who God is, how much He loves us, and how we can live in a way that honors Him!

"The truth is that wisdom starts in our hearts. When we want what God wants, that's when we realize we don't have all the answers. And that's when wisdom begins to grow in us. God's wisdom is so very precious! So let's all keep asking God for wisdom and letting His truth shape how we live. Remember, be wise because your choices matter!"

#### \*Finding verses with 2nd-3rd graders

- ① Guide them to open their Bibles to the front and find the table of contents. (HOLD UP A BIBLE OPENED TO THE TABLE OF CONTENTS TO SHOW THE KIDS WHAT THE PAGE LOOKS LIKE.)

#### **Inclusive Pro Tips**

If your group works better in pairs, invite them to partner up and pray for one another. You can give them a prompt like, "Pray for your friend to be wise at school this week."

### (1) What You Do

#### Option 1

- 1. Give every kid a "Prayer" Activity Page.
- 2. Assist them to tape it onto their lima bean bag.
- 3. Encourage the kids to care for their beans at home by following the instructions on the page.
- 4. While they hold their lima bean bags, invite them to pray silently to God, asking for His wisdom to flood their minds as they make choices this week so they can grow strong and beautiful lives!

#### Option 2

- 1. Gather the kids in a circle.
- 2. Give every kid an index card and a pencil.
- Invite the kids to think about a time they might need wisdom this week.
  - → While playing on the playground with friends.
  - → During a sports game.
  - → Responding to a parent.
  - → Making the right choices during class.
  - → Looking out for others in need.
- 4. Direct them to write or draw about it on their index card.
- 5. Invite them to pray silently to God, asking for His wisdom to flood their minds as they make choices this week so they can grow strong and beautiful lives!
- 6. Close the group in prayer.

## ② What You Say

"Dear God, thank You for showing us how important our choices are. Thank You for Jesus, who not only showed us how to live wisely, but also gave us a way to be close to You! We want to live like Him! Please fill our hearts with Your wisdom. Remind us to read Your Word, and surround ourselves with others who follow Your Son, Jesus. We love You, God, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen."

Transition → As grown-ups arrive to pick up, invite the kids to show off their lima bean bags. Encourage them to tell their grown-ups what they learned from the true story of the kings: be wise because your choices matter!
