
In the beginning, God created everything! He created the heavens and the Earth and everything in it—including you and me!




The serpent tricked Eve into eating the fruit that God said not to eat.






After eating the fruit from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, Adam and Eve hid from God. But God already knew what they had done.




