NBC SERVE CARDS


The NBC Nominating Team is gearing up for 2026! Serve Cards will be available on

A Note from the *Director of Music & Education*

Did you know that God has a first name?...well it says so right there in a song! “Andy walks with me, Andy talks with me, Andy tells me I am His own!”

That joke always comes to mind whenever I sing the song *In the Garden*. The choir probably gets tired of my jokes, but I made it back in June when we began to prepare to sing *In the Garden* earlier this summer. It is an anthem that we have done in the past and I like to pull it out when we need something quick and easy to throw together quickly. The hymn text and tune were both composed by Charles Austin Miles (1868-1946), who was known as a pharmacist before he turned to writing gospel songs. He is most famously known for the tune and text, *In the Garden*. When researching Charles, I came across this quote, “It is as a writer of gospel songs I am proud to be known, for in that way I may be of the most use to my Master, whom I serve willingly although not as efficiently as is my desire.” I pray that in whatever we do, while it may not be writing gospel songs, that we would do so with the passion of Charles and seek to use our own gifts and abilities to bring honor to God.
