

A Note from the Director of Music & Education

Did you know that God has a first name?...well it says so right there in a song! "Andy walks with me, Andy talks with me, Andy tells me I am His own!"

That joke always comes to mind whenever I sing the song *In the Garden*. The choir probably gets tired of my jokes, but I made it back in June when we began to prepare to sing *In the Garden* earlier this summer. It is an anthem that we have done in the past and I like to pull it out when we need something quick and easy to throw together quickly. The hymn text and tune were both composed by Charles Austin Miles (1868-1946), who was known as a pharmacist before he turned to writing gospel songs. He is most famously known for the tune and text, *In the Garden*.
