Support the NSC emergency teams with leadership, guidance, equipment and administration in order to successfully support each emergency team's mission.

Maintain constant surveillance for any safety hazard in the church and on the grounds. We will promptly resolve safety issues as soon as possible in order to provide safety assurance for all members and visitors.

Safety experience is desired but not required. We are always on duty when at the church.
"We look for problems!"
It's certainly not hard work but it's important.
We look forward to you joining.

Provide a safe environment for all members and visitors of the church through our presence, intercession , and controlling the situations while maintaining a respectful demeanor toward all people, cooperating with all law enforcement officers, and reflecting our Christian values in everything we do.

A clear background check is required.
Training includes 8 to 10 hours of video training and follow up OJT. Also, a thorough knowledge of our Procedures and Techniques Manual.
Prior law enforcement or military experience is desired but not required. Being armed is not required. However, if you desire to carry, there will be additional training depending on experience and you must purchase private insurance.
Attendance at quarterly training is required.
Ladies are encouraged to join.
SheepDawgs serve every Sunday, several occasions during the week and special church events throughout the year.
