Celebrating Disaster Relief

I hope you are planning to join us for our annual Homecoming celebration on Sunday, October 5. This year we will be celebrating all that God has done at Goshen in establishing our disaster relief ministry.

Our speaker for the 10:45am worship service is Shawn Ames who serves as the Relief Ministries Director for SBC of Virginia. I'm excited to welcome Shawn to Goshen to preach God's Word regarding God's heart of compassion and how we get to be part of sharing that heart through disaster relief. I trust this will be a challenging and encouraging message for our church.

We also will be presenting the very first Goshen Legacy Award to Rev. John W. Gordon Jr. who served as Goshen's pastor from 1963-1967. Beth Yezierski will be here to accept the award on behalf of her father who died earlier this year. Rev. Gordon was instrumental in the early stages of SBC disaster relief ministry in Virginia. We are thankful for his ministry at Goshen and throughout Virginia and look forward to honoring his legacy of service with this first Goshen Legacy Award.

We will also collect a special offering during the worship service for our church's disaster relief ministry. 100% of the money you give to this offering will be used to support the work God is doing through Goshen in disaster relief. We hope you will come ready to give to support this important work.

Our worship service will be followed by a potluck meal in the fellowship hall. Please plan to stay for this wonderful time of fellowship. We ask that you bring a main dish and a side or dessert to share. We want to ensure that we have plenty of food for any guests who may join us on this special day.

During the meal, you will have a couple of additional special opportunities. The first is to step inside our newly donated and outfitted disaster relief trailer. The trailer will be here on site and open during lunch for you to see it. Our disaster relief volunteers are understandably very proud of this trailer. So many of you have helped get it prepared in various ways, and we want to take advantage of this opportunity to show it off.

We also will have Sarah Dye with us. Sarah is the author of a new book called To Give & To Gain: The Women of Todd's Tavern Sewing Circle. The book highlights the stories of a group of remarkable women in our community who made up Todd's Tavern Sewing Circle. Among these women was Sophia Haney, the mother of Wade Haney and Barbara Faulconer. Sarah will have copies of her book available for you to purchase. She also will be here to sign the book and chat about it. Please come prepared with cash if you would like to purchase a copy of the book.

We have an exciting day planned for this year's Homecoming celebration. Be sure to be here and invite others to join us as well. God is at work through our church, and that's worth celebrating!

I want to share a little bit about the children's ministry conference I attended at the beginning of September.

The small group of us had such an amazing evening of fellowship and networking with other leaders in the area. Times like these always give me a little extra umph of motivation and excitement for things that will be happening in the life of Goshen.

In the beginning of the conference, the speaker Kris Buckman, asked us to raise our hand if we had accepted Jesus into our heart at the age of 10 or younger. Some hands went up. Then she asked to add hands of those who had accepted Jesus at the age of 18 or younger. Majority of hands were then in the air. As we looked around it left a lasting impression to see a room full of people who currently serve in the children's ministry that had been impacted at some point in their life by people exactly like those of us sitting in that room. Kris went on to say that no matter where she was speaking or what conference she was at, about 90% of people in attendance would have their hands raised as being saved at the age of 18 or younger. This demonstration shows just how important this area of ministry truly is.

We have such an amazing opportunity to share the gospel with these children and build a foundation that they will be able to stand on for the rest of their life. Their hearts are so tender and open, and we can help guide their journey of understanding God's love and gift of salvation. I feel so incredibly blessed to be a part of this journey for so many and look forward to what God has in store for our kids at Goshen.
