In 2022, COC chose to close and sell the facility. Over the next two years, Jim and Joan worked to relocate the residents. By last October, they had moved the final individuals to new homes across the country. With their work completed, they then moved to Bella Vista, Arkansas, to be near Joan's mother and family. Baptist Ministries Worldwide recently invited them to join the Care Team, focusing on supporting retired missionaries in a specific region and encouraging them in their transition to retirement. Rejoice that Joan recently underwent successful corrective hip surgery, and pray for Jim as he recovers from a recent knee replacement. In their words: "Thank you for your prayers and encouragement.
