

Teen Camp Rules

General:

Absolutely NO pranks.

Clean up after yourself.

Respect the campground. Pick up trash and use the trash cans.

Give your medicine to the nurse. Take your medicine.

Stick to the dress code.

Keep your hands to yourself.

No phones unless it's during phone time.

Do not scream at other teens or adults.

Be where you are supposed to be.

Do not go anywhere by yourself.

Do not go anywhere where you are not supposed to be.

Do not go into the woods at any time.

If you are hurt, tell someone.

Keep your wristbands on.

Respect your counselors and leaders.

Don't touch any equipment.

Be on time.

No trading points.

Wake up on time and arrive on time.

Be fully clothed when walking to and from the bathhouse.

You must be on the quad during quad time.

Everyone has a 15-minute shower time.

No going into cabins during the day to take a nap or hang out. If you need something, you must bring an adult with you to go in. (Unless it's during downtime).

Cabins:

Absolutely NO switching cabins.

Lights out means go to sleep. No playing around or loud talking.

Sleep in your assigned room.

Don't get in any others' beds.

The entire cabin must be present at the dining hall before you get in line.

Keep your cabin clean (points will be awarded each day to the team with the cleanest boys' and girls' cabin)

Keep your stuff in your area.

Don't touch other people's stuff.

Dining Hall:

Stay out of the kitchen.

Clean up after yourselves.

If you move a chair, return it to its original position before you leave.

Service:

You must 'clean up' before service.

Do not talk or disrupt the service.

No restroom breaks during service. (There will be time right before the service to use the restroom.)

During service and altar times, stay in the tabernacle.

Focus on the Lord, not others around you.
