2025 Accomplishments

Throughout 2025, the Outreach Committee has continued to faithfully steward resources and ministry partnerships to support the Chapel vision – “To develop mature Christians who compassionately respond to the needs of others.”

Mission Engagement Highlights

- Continued to review and adjust the portfolio of supported ministries, including adding and removing ministries as appropriate.
- Supported disaster relief through Samaritan’s Purse for victims of the California fires, the North Carolina hurricanes and the floods in Texas.
- Sponsored local initiatives including ministry presentations at the Mens Breakfasts, donations of craft supplies to Families in Transition, the Nest Baby Bottle campaign and the annual City Rescue Mission sock drive.
- Hosted several ministry presentations including Honduras Outreach International, Salvation Army, Charis House, Seafarers’ Mission and Cru Story Runners.

Financial Stewardship

- On target to provide over \$450,000 of financial support to 40 ministries through budgeted and one-time financial donations.
- Managed quarterly disbursements and the annual budget process with transparency and prayerful oversight. Administered the annual process to collect and analyze financial information for our supported ministries.
- Took advantage of several matching fund opportunities to double the financial impact of the Chapel donations.

Staffing and Operational Management

- Continued to foster and maintain a committed Outreach Committee consisting of fourteen people. Welcomed and onboarded two new committee members to fill open roles this year.
- Continued work to update the Outreach information on the Chapel website and the printed Outreach brochure.
- Worked closely with the Chapel Board to adjust policies, processes and budgets to stay aligned with the objectives of the Chapel.
