

Please note that your information is never shared and will only be used to contact you during an emergency cancellation.


Hope Office Closed on January 19

Nominee for Council President

With gratitude for the trust placed in me, I am willing to continue serving with prayerful discernment, steady leadership, and a heart for Hope Lutheran Church's mission and future.

I am a good listener and bring ideas, questions, and comments from members of the church to the Council table. I am well organized and attend to details. Most importantly, I love Jesus!!


Nominee for Council Member-at-Large


Become a Member of Hope Lutheran Church
