THE ENDLESS PURSUIT OF REST

Two disappointed disciples (Lk. 24:13-17)

The pointless pursuit (Lk. 24:21)

- Pursuing rest through a man-made religious system (Lk. 24:18-19)
- Pursuing rest by gaining victory over corrupt leaders (Lk. 24:20)
- Pursuing rest by achieving political triumph (Lk. 24:21)

- Pursuing rest by pursuing “the good life” (Lk. 12:19-20)

- Pursuing rest through the wisdom of men (1 Cor. 2:5)

CHRIST PROVIDES REST

Christ is the provider of peace and rest (Lk. 1:79; Jn. 14:27; Ro. 5:1; Jn. 20:19)

Provided through Christ's cross (Lk. 24:25-27; Col. 1:20)

Provided by Christ's personal presence with you (Lk. 24:28-35)

Rest is found in the presence of the resurrected Christ (Mt. 11:28)
