I was nervous about the situation but she has been fine and I think getting her out of that bad living situation has improved her immensely. She's working very hard teaching English and she often wakes up at 3:30 in the morning to catch the 4:30 a.m. train to the city. She usually gets home around seven or eight at night

We helped clean up her apartment, and she took out a small loan to be able to pay for the deposit on a smaller apartment that her ex-boyfriend would not be able to access. If everything goes well, she will move in on the first of January.

It's been a little bit stressful on Krista, just having a louder house, and a lot more dishes and cooking and cleaning but we both team up on that. But there's also a lot of laughter and joy especially since she is doing so well.

Roxie is doing fine. She graduated last year and moved in with us. We had a small scare in September because we received the annual utility bills for gas electricity and power and forgot to factor in three people living there instead of two. But God provided as He always does. Roxie is working as a teacher at the same school as Krista and hopes to save up enough money by next summer to move out and work and go to school part time to pursue a master's degree.

Krista had one of the students over today and they spend a lot of time out in her workshop.

Phil wrote earlier this week that there would be a Christmas gift coming so I wanted to make sure he passed on our thanks and appreciation for whatever that is. I remember when we used to do this when I was on the Missions Committee so many years ago, and it's really a wonderful thing

that you do. Not only financially but just to be remembered this time of year
