LESSON OVERVIEW

Revelation: Honor Is Heaven’s Value

Story: 2 Kings 4:8-37

Heart: When you see people through the eyes of Father God, you see them as worth everything, they become important to you.

Memory Verse: “Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourself.” - Romans 12:10

SUPPLIES NEEDED

Game 1:

- 6 Scooter Boards (3 per team)

Game 2:

- Red Solo Cups (10 per player)
- 2 Tables
- Timer

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Page Team Lead for all communication of needs (supplies, parent assistance, medical, restroom breaks)
- NEVER leave the classroom without paging Team Lead
- NEVER be alone with a child – this includes one on one conversations
- NO pictures or video recording is allowed in the classroom
- Every child and serve team member MUST wear their name tag

CONNECT WITH GOD FOCUS

This month we are focusing on connecting with God through Compassion.

Psalms 86:15 says, "But You, Lord, are a compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness."

Did you know that the word compassion actually means, "to suffer with"? If you have been sad, angry or upset, wouldn't it make you feel better to know that a friend or parent cares about you and wants to help? Compassion is taking action to show others that we care about them.

The Bible says God is full of compassion. He didn't just look at the world covered with sin and evil and say, "Those poor people. Too bad, so sad..." No! He came down into the world to suffer with His people so He could make things right. Jesus was often "moved with compassion" before He went to heal someone. When we have compassion on others we are being like Jesus. Just like Jesus was moved with compassion, we also can be moved with compassion. We can connect with God by caring for others the way Jesus did!

ACTIVATION | Let's pray together. "God, thank you for having compassion on me by sending Jesus to save me. Holy Spirit, will you give me your heart of compassion for other people. Help me to see others the way you see them. I know that caring for others makes you happy, so I want to be full of compassion just like you! Amen."

FORTIFY WITH SCRIPTURE

"Then Jesus called his disciples to him and said, "I have compassion on the crowd because they have been with me now three days and have nothing to eat. And I am unwilling to send them away hungry, lest they faint on the way."

REVELATION

We’re beginning a new series called Honor. Honor is showing respect to others in your thoughts, your words, and your actions. Honor is not earned, honor is given. When you see people through the eyes of Father God, you see them as worth everything, they become important to you.

God saw you as valuable and assigned heaven’s value for you and gave everything just to be in relationship with you. God gave His very best for you by giving Jesus. You were worth it all for Him. You could never earn or deserve the honor God gave to you. **Our revelation today is Honor is Heaven’s value.**

Let’s pray, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don’t make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.



BIBLE STORY

TEACHER PROMPT | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

BIBLE STORY INTRO | Our Bible story today is found in 2 Kings 4:8-37.

A prophet named Elisha went to Shunem. An important woman lived there. You are important. Say that with me, “I am important.” The woman did everything she could to get Elisha to come over so she could feed him dinner. After that, anytime Elisha came through her town he would stop at her house to eat.

The Shunammite woman wanted to show Elisha honor by going out of her way to be kind to him. She wasn’t trying to gain his favor to get anything from him. She simply wanted to show him honor because she recognized he was a man of God.

One day, she had an idea to build a room for Elisha to rest in when he traveled to Shunem. She and her husband not only built the room but filled it with furniture to honor Elisha.

The Shunamite woman was a woman of Honor, she showed heavens value of Elisha.

One day when the Prophet Elisha came into town and stayed with her, and had his servant call her to him, he asked her “what can I do for you” since she had showed him much honor. She replied, “I have a home with my own people”, she was saying there was nothing that she wanted from him. Elisha and his servant discussed about her and how she had no child, and her husband was old, he then prophesied over her saying “about this time next year, you will have a son”. She was in unbelief but the next year just as the prophet had said, she gave birth to a son. Because she showed great honor to Elisha, God gave her more than she even asked for.

Many years later the child grew sick and died. The Shunamite woman laid her son on the prophet’s bed that she had prepared many years before and went out to find Elisha. When Elisha made it to her home, he went and laid on top of the boy and made him warm. He put his mouth on his mouth, his eyes on his eyes, and his



hands on his hands. He did this two times, then the boy sneezed 7 times and opened his eyes. God raised this boy from the dead through the prophet Elisha, and because the Shunamite woman held him in such honor, God’s Dunamis Power was shown to her. Our revelation today is, **Honor is Heaven’s Value**.

TEACHER PROMPT | Ask Holy Spirit what He wants to do in this next moment. Ask Holy Spirit if this is a moment of repentance for not showing honor, or if this is a moment of impartation of honor, or both. Lead an altar call based on what Holy Spirit is saying.

SALVATION

TEACHER PROMPT | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!

SAY | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc, have everyone repeat prayer together)

PRAYER | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.

CELEBRATION | At TLC one of our values is Celebration. If you made this amazing decision to give your life to Jesus today, please stand up so we can CELEBRATE YOU! Let’s Celebrate our friends who gave their life to Jesus today! WOOHOO!!

BIBLE TRIVIA

TEACHER PROMPT | There are many ways you can do Bible trivia to keep it fun and exciting, get creative with this! Idea: Call up 1 boy and 1 girl, per question and have them line up on opposite sides of the stage. The first boy and girl in line will get the first question, whoever answers first gets a prize, if they do not know they can talk with their team to find the answer, whoever answers first gets a prize.

1. (This is a new question) What does 'God is the Alpha and Omega' mean?

(God is the beginning and the end)

2. What was our memory verse?

(Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourself. Romans 12:10)

3. What was our revelation?

(Honor is Heaven's value)

4. What was our Bible Story about?

(Any answer related to the Bible story is acceptable)

5. How did the Shunamite woman know the Prophet Elisha?

(She would feed him every time he came into town.)

6. What did the Prophet Elisha prophecy over the Shunamite woman?

(That by that time next year she would have a son.)

7. When her son was older what happened to him?

(He died.)



GAME TIME

Game 1

Supplies:

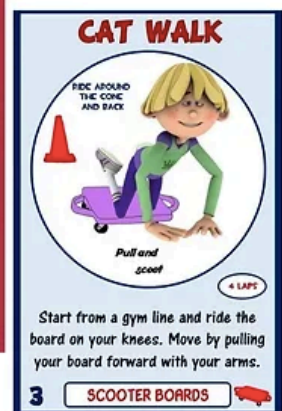
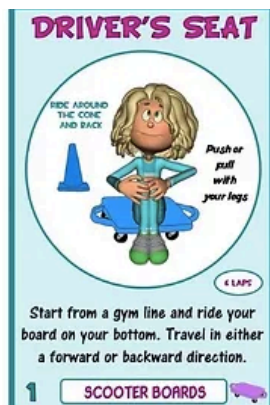
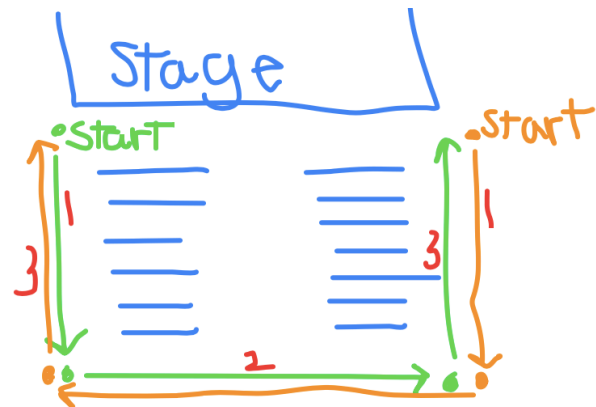
- 6 Scooter Boards (3 per team)

Set up:

- Place all 6 scooters throughout the room as pictured

Instructions:

- Call up 6 players, place time on two teams, 3 per team.
- Both teams will play at the same time.
- Team 1 will start on the left of stage and team 2 will start on the right.
- Have one player per team to go to each scooter.
- The 1st player will ride it down the row in driver's seat position
- The 2nd player will ride it down the next portion in alligator crawl position
- The 3rd player will ride it back up in catwalk position
- This is a relay race, so player 1 begins, tags player 2, player 2 then goes and tags player 3, player 3 ends the race by making it back to the stage before the other team.
- Play 1-4 rounds





Game 2

Supplies:

- Red Solo Cups (10 per player)
- 2 Tables
- Timer

Set Up:

- Place red solo cups on the tables (20 per table, 10 per “spot”)
- Prepare timer

Instructions:

- Call up 4 players
- Each player will compete to make a pyramid the fastest. Whichever team can make the pyramid the fastest wins
- Play 4 rounds
