LESSON OVERVIEW

Revelation: Immanuel God is with Me

Bible Lesson: Matthew 27+28

Heart: Jesus is the Son of God and He came down to earth to make a way for us to be with Father God. He is Immanuel: God with us

Memory Verse: “Then you will call my name. You will come to me and pray to me, and I will listen to you.” – Jeremiah 29:12

REVELATION

This month we will unpack different names of God and how His names show us who He is.

The prophet Isaiah described the savior of the worlds as Immanuel. Today we will find out exactly what Immanuel means!

Isaiah 7:14 “The Lord himself will give you a sign. The virgin is going to have a baby. She will give birth to a son. And he will be called Immanuel.”

Our revelation today is Immanuel God is with me.

Let’s pray, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don’t make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.

BIBLE LESSON

TEACHER PROMPT | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

BIBLE LESSON INTRO | Our Bible lesson today is found in Matthew 27+28

Jesus came to Earth and lived a life without any sin. He never did anything wrong, ever! He is 100% Holy. He came to reform the crooked ways of people, to take the penalty of sin and the ways of sin to make people right before God. He came to make a way so that God could be with his people.

Jesus is Immanuel, God with us.

A lot of people loved Jesus and knew He was the savior that was promised to come, but the Jewish leaders did not agree. They wanted to kill Him for claiming that He was the Son of God.

They plotted and had Jesus arrested and taken to a trial, the governor who had the right to set one prisoner free a year knew Jesus as innocent. He went before the



crowd of Jews hoping to set Jesus free, but they shouted to free a man named Barabbas instead because they wanted Jesus to be crucified on a cross.

Remember this is what Jesus came to do, He was not surprised when they decided to send Him to the cross. He was prepared to die for even those who hated Him and hurt Him. Jesus loves everyone. Jesus had the end of the story in mind, He knew that He came as Immanuel, who is God with us, and the only way that God could be with His people again was through the cross.

After beating Jesus, the soldiers went on to nail Jesus to the cross, where He would die for everyone's sins. When Jesus took His final breath He said, "It is finished", then He gave up His Spirit. The curtain that hung in the temple, separating the Holy Place from people was torn in two making a way for God to be with His people.

Jesus rose from the dead after 3 days and went to heaven to be seated at the right hand of Father God. He sent His Holy Spirit to live inside of His believers and to give them power.

Jesus made a way for God to live in His people. Jesus is Immanuel.

Our revelation today is, Immanuel, God is with me.

TEACHER PROMPT | Ask Holy Spirit what He wants to do in this next moment. This can look like leading children to encounter Jesus who is God with them, to invite Him into their hearts and invited Holy Spirit to come live inside of them.

SALVATION + DISCUSSION

TEACHER PROMPT | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!

SAY | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close



to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc. have everyone repeat prayer together)

PRAYER | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.

CELEBRATION | At TLC one of our values is Celebration. If you made this amazing decision to give your life to Jesus today, please stand up so we can CELEBRATE YOU! Let's Celebrate our friends who gave their life to Jesus today! WOOHOO!!
