LESSON OVERVIEW

Revelation: God’s Favor Follows my Obedience

Bible Lesson: Ruth 1+2

Heart: Ruth chose to serve her mother-in-law, Naomi, over her own desires and God blessed her. He gave her favor because of it.

Memory Verse: “Blessed is she who has believed that what the Lord has said to her will be accomplished.” – Luke 1:45

REVELATION

SAY | Great leaders are great servants. The Bible tells us in Luke 22:24-27, Jesus came to serve and not to be served. Jesus did not walk the earth looking for what people could do for Him. While He walked the earth, Jesus traveled to find people to serve. The heart of a servant pleases God.

Today we will discover a Wonder Woman of the Bible who chose to serve her mother-in-law over her own wants and God blessed her and gave her favor because of it!

Our revelation today is God’s Favor Follows my Obedience

Let’s pray, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don’t make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.

BIBLE LESSON

TEACHER PROMPT | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

BIBLE LESSON INTRO | Our Bible lesson today is found in Ruth 1+2

There was a great famine, which means there was no food, in the land of Judah and a man named Elimelech and His wife Naomi, along with their two sons went to go stay in the land of Moab to survive. Naomi’s husband, Elimelech, later died and her two sons married women from Moab named Ruth and Orpah.

After about 10 years both of Naomi’s sons also died, she was left with her two daughters-in-law, Ruth and Orpah. The famine was over, and Naomi decided to return back to her land of Judah, she told Ruth and Orpah, “Go, return each of you to your mother’s house, and the Lord be as kind to you as you have been to me.” So they both cried and Orpah kissed her mother-in-law goodbye, but Ruth decided in her heart to stay with her. She said to Naomi, “Where you go, I will go. Where you stay, I will stay. Your people, will be my people and your God, my God.” Naomi



agreed to have Ruth come with her and they made their way back to Judah to Bethlehem.

There was a rich man named Boaz who was one of Naomi’s close relatives from her husband’s, Elimelech’s, family. One day Ruth, said to Naomi, “Let me go to the fields. Maybe someone will be kind and let me gather the grain he leaves in his field.” Naomi said yes!

Ruth found favor in the eyes of Boaz and because of her obedience to God in blessing her mother-in-law Naomi, Boaz allowed her to come and pick up any extra grain that was in the field each day.

Ruth faithfully worked in the fields just as her mother-in-law asked her to. You may not work in a field like Ruth did, but did you know that everywhere you go it is a field that you can serve in? Your home, your school, and your church! All of these are fields that you can serve in and as you do it as unto the Lord, the Favor of God will meet you. Turn and tell your neighbor what you are hearing Holy Spirit say about our revelation and Bible story today.

Our revelation today is, God’s Favor Follows My Obedience.

ACTIVATION | This week, go out of your way to help someone and be a blessing. If the thought comes, “I wonder what they will do for me if I do this,” reject that thought because that’s serving to get something in return from someone. That’s strings attached! Jesus didn’t serve, love, or give with that motive. Jesus was only motivated by love for the Father.

TEACHER PROMPT | Ask Holy Spirit what He wants to do in this next moment.

SALVATION + DISCUSSION

TEACHER PROMPT | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!

SAY | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close



to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc. have everyone repeat prayer together)

PRAYER | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.

CELEBRATION | At TLC one of our values is Celebration. If you made this amazing decision to give your life to Jesus today, please stand up so we can CELEBRATE YOU! Let’s Celebrate our friends who gave their life to Jesus today! WOOHOO!!
