

FEAR GO - "KICK OUT FEAR"

LESSON OVERVIEW

Revelation: Kick Out Fear

Bible Lesson: 1 Kings 19:1-8, 2 Kings 9:30-37

Heart: Elijah and Jehu both experienced fear. Jehu kicked out fear by remaining

strong in the Lord and in His power.

Memory Verse: "For God did not give us a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a

sound mind." – 2 Timothy 1:7

REVELATION

SAY | We're continuing our series called Fear Go. Say "FEAR GO!"

We will unpack our revelation KICK OUT FEAR. You will learn how the presence of God and power from the Holy Spirit KICK OUT FEAR in our lives. Before jumping into our Bible story, I will ask you a question, but I want you to take your time to think about your answer.

ASK | Do we need to be afraid when we have God with us? (Pause and allow for a response) No. We do not need to be afraid. Sometimes we can feel fear. And that's all that fear is...a feeling. Fear will always lie to us and make us think that a situation we are in is too scary or too big for God. But that is not true. Our Father God is POWERFUL, and nothing is too much for Him.

SAY | Romans 8:31 says "If God is for us, then no one can defeat us" (ICB)

No one and nothing can defeat you. As children of God the power or Dunamis that we receive through Holy Spirit prepares you for anything Father God calls you to do. When fear shows up KICK OUT FEAR with the Word of God! If you do not know the word of God, you cannot respond with the Word of God and KICK OUT FEAR. Romans 8:31 "If God is for us, then no one can defeat us" is a great scripture to memorize and KICK OUT FEAR

Our revelation today is KICK OUT FEAR.

Let's pray, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don't make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.

BIBLE LESSON

TEACHER PROMPT | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

BIBLE LESSON INTRO | Our Bible lesson today is found in 1 Kings 19:1-8 and 2 Kings 9:30-37



Today we will discover two different men, one named Elijah, and the other Jehu. Elijah and Jehu both experienced fear, one let the voice of fear talk to him, where the other Kicked Out Fear. I want you to pay close attention to the difference between the two men.

Our story picks up after Elijah defeated all the false prophets of Baal when he called down fire from Heaven and God consumed the altar. King Ahab heard of this and told his wife Jezebel. Say "JEZEBEL".

Jezebel did what was evil in the eyes of God, she worshiped and served the false god Baal. When she heard that Elijah had proved that the God of Israel was the one true God and Baal had been proven as false and his false prophets were killed by Elijah, she was not happy. She sent a messenger to Elijah saying "By this time tomorrow I will kill you. I will kill you as you killed those prophets. If I don't succeed, may the gods punish me terribly."

Elijah, the guy who just defeated all the evil people, allowed fear to speak to him and he very was afraid, he ran away to a desert. Then Elijah prayed to God (pause). What do you think he prayed? (pause for response) Remember Elijah was a great man of faith, do you think he prayed a prayer of faith and power? Nope! He allowed the message of fear to take hold of him and he prayed, "I have had enough, Lord. Let me die. I am no better than my ancestors." (Pause to take that in)

Instead of Elijah kicking out fear like he knew to do, Elijah believed the lie of the enemy that he shouldn't even be alive. (Pause and ask Holy Spirit if anyone in the room is entertaining the same lie. If you discern yes, stop and invite children into prayer and deliverance in this moment)

He fell asleep and woke up to an Angel who had brought him food and water, just what God knew he needed to be strengthened.

The Lord told Elijah to anoint a man named Jehu as king over Israel and He told Elijah that Jezebel would be defeated and be eating by dogs! Now once Jehu was anointed, he went up to the town of Jezreel and saw Jezebel at the top of the tower looking out of her window. She asked him if he had come in peace, and he



looked up and saw the men standing next to her at the window and said "Throw her down!" so they threw her down and she died and was eaten by dogs just like the prophet Elijah said. Jehu kicked out fear by defeating the evil queen Jezebel instead of running from her.

When you listen to the voice of fear, you are no longer allowing God to work in his Power through you. When we kick out fear, obey God, and are led by the Holy Spirit, evil can't stand a chance!

TEACHER PROMPT | Take a moment to ask children if they have been listening to the voice of fear and need to repent and follow God and kick out fear. Ask Holy Spirit what He wants to do in the room.

SALVATION + DISCUSSION

TEACHER PROMPT | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!

SAY | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc. have everyone repeat prayer together)

PRAYER | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.

CELEBRATION | At TLC one of our values is Celebration. If you made this amazing decision to give your life to Jesus today, please stand up so we can CELEBRATE YOU! Let's Celebrate our friends who gave their life to Jesus today! WOOHOO!!

BENEDICTION PRAYER

"Teach us your ways that we may know you and find your favor." – Exodus 33:13

BIBLE TRIVIA

1. What are the three "omni" words we have been learning about and what do they mean?

(God is everywhere always, omnipresent. God is all knowing, omniscient. God is all powerful, omnipotent)

2. What was our memory verse?

(For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, of love, and a sound mind. 2 Tim. 1:7)

3. What was our revelation?

(Kick Out Fear)

4. What was our Bible Story about?

(Anything pertaining to the Bible story is accepted)

5. Last week learned about Gideon and how God used him to save Israel, what was the first thing the Angel of the Lord told Gideon to do.

(Tear down the Altar of Baal and the Asherah pole and create an altar to God)



6. God told Gideon to get rid of most of the army and brought the number of men down to 300. Why did God do this?

(So that they would know that it wasn't by their own power or strength that they defeated the Midianites but by Gods Power.)

7. Last week in the lesson there was a warning for us, what was it?

(To not only say "fear go, Holy Spirit come" when we are afraid, but to say "Holy Spirit come" daily, or to want His presence and not just His Power.)
