LESSON OVERVIEW

Revelation: God Does Miracles Through Me

Bible Lesson: John 6:1-15

Heart: God loves to use His people to do miracles. Just like he used the disciples with the loaves and fish, He is eager to use you.

Memory Verse: “A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other.” – 1 Corinthians 12:6+7 (Wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, miracles, prophecy, recognizing different spirits, speaking in tongues, and interpretation of tongues)

REVELATION

SAY | Today we are continuing our series on the Gifts of the Spirit. What spiritual gifts have you received? What spiritual gifts are you believing to receive? (Allow for a response)

This month we are going to be learning about the gifts of the spirit and how Father God has GIVEN these gifts to us. You might wonder if it's a gift that He has given, why are you not walking in them yet. Honestly, that's a great question! It's important to remember that just like the gift of salvation, we receive these gifts by faith and invitation into our life. I am looking forward to what God has in store for us as we learn about the gifts of the spirit. We declare that faith to receive these gifts is rising inside of you! Father God is the best gift giver!

Does anyone know what a miracle is? (allow for response) In the Greek it is the word, DUNAMIS. Does anyone know what Dunamis means? (allow for response) Dunamis is when God's power is at work! This power does things that are beyond what we can do ourselves, it is Gods own hand and ability. When we say "God did a miracle" we are saying God did something that we could never do on our own.

Our revelation today is, God Does Miracles Through Me.

Let's pray, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don't make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.

BIBLE LESSON

TEACHER PROMPT | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

BIBLE LESSON INTRO | Our Bible lesson today is found in John 6:1-15

Before we read the Bible story, I want you to take a moment to think about a miracle you may be believing for in your life, in your family, or for someone else.



(Take a moment to let children think, give examples to prompt, maybe a personal miracle you're believing for currently) If you have something you are believing God for that is impossible for you, stand up! We are going to pray for you, if you see anyone around you standing lay hands on them while we pray. (Take the next moment to spiritually lead and pray and believe for miracles).

Our Bible story begins today as Jesus went up on a mountainside and sat down with his disciples. "Jesus looked up and saw a large crowd coming toward him. So, he said to Philip, "Where can we buy bread for these people to eat?" He asked this only to test Philip. He already knew what he was going to do. Philip answered him, "Suppose we were able to buy enough bread for each person to have just a bite. That would take more than half a year's pay!" Another of his disciples spoke up. It was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He said, "Here is a boy with five small loaves of barley bread. He also has two small fish. But how far will that go in such a large crowd?" Jesus said, "Have the people sit down." There was plenty of grass in that place, and they sat down. About 5,000 men were there. Then Jesus took the loaves and gave thanks. He handed out the bread to those who were seated. He gave them as much as they wanted. And he did the same with the fish. When all of them had enough to eat, Jesus spoke to his disciples. "Gather the leftover pieces," he said. "Don't waste anything." So, they gathered what was left over from the five barley loaves. They filled 12 baskets with the pieces left by those who had eaten. The people saw the sign that Jesus did. Then they began to say, "This must be the Prophet who is supposed to come into the world." But Jesus knew that they planned to come and force him to be their king. So, he went away again to a mountain by himself.

TEACHER, if you have a personal story of welcoming the Holy Spirit into a situation, please share! It is so important for the children to hear about real life experiences that take place. They will overcome by the blood of the lamb, and the word of our testimony!

Our revelation today is, God Does Miracles Through Me.



TEACHER PROMPT | TLC Kids is children's ministry. The moment you are about to shift into is a BIG moment. You will lead the children into receiving the Gift of Miracles. This gift will lead and guide them the way no other man can. Play worship music and steward this moment as you have experienced in the sanctuary. There is no jr. Holy Spirit in this house.

SALVATION + DISCUSSION

TEACHER PROMPT | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!

SAY | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc. have everyone repeat prayer together)

PRAYER | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.

CELEBRATION | At TLC one of our values is Celebration. If you made this amazing decision to give your life to Jesus today, please stand up so we can CELEBRATE YOU! Let's Celebrate our friends who gave their life to Jesus today! WOOHOO!!
