



## PROPHECY – “HERE I AM, SEND ME”

### LESSON OVERVIEW

**Revelation:** Here I am, Send me!

**Story:** Isaiah 6:1-9, Isaiah 9:6+7, Isaiah 61:1

**Heart:** In this lesson, children will see how God purified Isaiah and sent him as a prophet to spread hope about the coming Messiah.

**Memory Verse:** “And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see vision, and your old men shall dream dreams.” – Acts 2:17

### SUPPLIES NEEDED

## CONNECT WITH GOD FOCUS

### REVELATION

Today we will discover another Messenger of God, Isaiah, who said “Here I am, send me!” Say it with me “Here I am, send me!”

Isaiah was a man who lived in Israel and was used by God to bring messages from God of the coming Messiah, Jesus, and messages for the future.

Many of Isaiah’s prophecies came true, and the most important one was about the savior of the World, Jesus!

- + Close your eyes and listen carefully “For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.”

Does this sound like something you have heard before? Isaiah prophesied this 700 years before Jesus was born! Holy Spirit revealed the future to Him! It sounds wild, but God knows everything, He knows what happened yesterday, He knows what will happen today, and He already knows what will happen tomorrow!

**Our revelation today is HERE I AM, SEND ME.**

**Let’s pray**, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don’t make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.



## BIBLE STORY

**TEACHER PROMPT** | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

**BIBLE STORY INTRO** | Our Bible story today is found in Isaiah 6.

One day God showed Isaiah a vision, or a spiritual daydream. Everyone close your eyes tight and try to imagine what he saw!

Isaiah saw God's ginormous golden throne in Heaven. Then he saw the train, or the back part, of Gods robe and it filled the whole room! Open your eyes! What colors did you see? (pause and let the kids imagine what this would have looked like) Okay close your eyes again! Isaiah then saw heavenly beings, with 1,2,3,4,5,6 wings. They were all saying "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord almighty; the whole earth is full of His glory." Over and over and over and over, the power of their voices shook everything and the temple was full of smoke!. Open your eyes! Did you see the 6 wings? What did it look like to you? What color was the smoke? (pause for response)

This was an amazing sight to see for Isaiah. Compared to God's Holiness, Isaiah saw how impure, or not holy, he was. He saw the sin that was in his heart and the people around him. He said "Oh, no! I will be destroyed. I am not pure. And I live among people who are not pure."

Do you think God pulled out some cleaner and sprayed Isaiah down to make Him clean? No, of course not!

The impurity, or sin, wasn't on Isaiah's skin but in his heart. Remember that heavenly being with the 6 wings? He took a burning coal from the altar and touched Isaiah's lips. God said "Look, your guilt is taken away because this hot coal has touched your lips. Your sin is taken away." Isaiah was cleansed by God; God forgave His sins!



Then Isaiah heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Who will I send? And who will go for us to spread my message?” Isaiah said, “Here am I, send me!”

God gave us Jesus to wipe away our Sin, like the hot coal that touched Isaiah’s lips! When God asks us to go and spread His message of Jesus, we are filled with His POWER and can reply to God, "Here I am, send me!"

**SAY | HERE I AM, SEND ME**

**TEACHER PROMPT** | If you want to be sent by God like Isaiah let’s pray. Repeat after me “Holy Spirit, come fill me, speak to me, I am ready to be your messenger, Here I am, Send me! Amen.”

## **SALVATION+ RECAP**

**TEACHER PROMPT** | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!

**SAY** | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc, have everyone repeat prayer together)

**PRAYER** | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.

**CELEBRATION** | At TLC one of our values is Celebration. If you made this amazing decision to give your life to Jesus today, please stand up so we can CELEBRATE YOU! Let’s Celebrate our friends who gave their life to Jesus today! WOOHOO!!

## **BIBLE TRIVIA**

**TEACHER PROMPT** | There are many ways you can do Bible trivia to keep it fun and exciting, get creative with this! Idea: Call up 1 boy and 1 girl, per question and have them line up on opposite sides of the stage. The first boy and girl in line will get the first question, whoever answers first gets a prize, if they do not know they can talk with their team to find the answer, whoever answers first gets a prize.

### **1. What was our memory verse?**

(Acts 2:17 “And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams”)

### **2. What was our revelation?**

(Here I am, Send Me!)

### **3. What was our Bible Story about?**

(God purified Isaiah and sent him as a prophet to spread hope about the coming Messiah Jesus.)

### **4. What is a prophet?**

(Someone who speaks Gods words to His people.)

### **5. What was Isaiah’s response to God when He saw the Holiness of God?**

(He saw that he was not holy. He said “I am not pure”)



## 6. Why did Isaiah say, “Here I am, send Me”?

(God said who can I send as a messenger.)

## GAME TIME

### Game

Supplies:

- Gummy Bears
- Whipped Cream
