LESSON OVERVIEW

Revelation: God Delivers His Promise

Bible Lesson: Luke 1+2

Heart: God promised to send a savior to make a way for us to be with Him. That savior is Jesus: Immanuel.

Memory Verse: “For to us a child is born, to us a son is give, and the government will be on his shoulders, and He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace” – Isaiah 9:6

REVELATION

SAY | We are continuing our series, Immanuel!

Raise your hand if you have ever made a promise and kept it. (pause) Now let's be authentic and raise your hand if you have ever made a promise and did not keep it? (pause) Stand up if you have ever been promised something but it didn't happen. (pause and have them sit back down)

Keeping promises is important to us and important others. God always keeps His promises. He is good and will never lie to you. Today we will discover one of the most important promises God kept to His people and why it is important to us even today. **Our revelation today is God Delivers His Promise.**

Let's pray, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don't make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.

BIBLE LESSON

TEACHER PROMPT | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

BIBLE LESSON INTRO | Our Bible lesson today is found in Luke 1+2

Last week we discovered that God Promised Jesus and how the prophets spoke that Jesus would be Immanuel, God with us, that He would be born in Bethlehem of an unmarried woman, He would carry God's mighty and wonderful name and bring peace. Today Our Bible story can be found in Luke 1-2, where we will see all these prophecies come true!

Mary and Joseph were engaged to be married, an angel of the Lord named Gabriel appeared to Mary and said "Greetings! The Lord has blessed you and is with you" but Mary was very confused and said, "what does this mean?" and the angel said to her "do not be afraid, Mary, because God is pleased with you!" He went on to tell her that she would become pregnant with a Son by the Holy Spirit and His



name would be Jesus. Gabriel said “He will be great, and people will call him the Son of the Most High... He will rule and His kingdom will never end.”

Mary became pregnant and there was an order in the land that everyone must go to their hometowns and must list their names in a register. Mary and Joseph went to Bethlehem and there was no room left in the inn so Mary had Jesus in a stable and wrapped the baby with cloths and laid him in a manger where the animals were fed.

That night, angels appeared to some shepherds in a field who were watching their sheep, and an angel of the Lord stood before them and the Glory of the Lord was shining all around them and they were afraid. And the angel said to them “fear not, for I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people, for unto you is born this day in the city of David, a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger. And suddenly there was with the angel many heavenly angels praising God and saying, “Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom He is pleased!”

When Jesus came to Earth, it happened just as God planned and promised. God delivered His promise to His people. This was the plan from the beginning, to save you and I from hell and restore us back to God! What an amazing and wonderful day!

Our revelation today is God Delivers His Promise!

TEACHER PROMPT | Ask Holy Spirit what He wants to do in this next moment. This is a great opportunity to thank God for His promise to save us and to lean into the salvation call. The Gospel is personal and is for our children.

SALVATION + DISCUSSION

TEACHER PROMPT | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!



SAY | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc. have everyone repeat prayer together)

PRAYER | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.

CELEBRATION | At TLC one of our values is Celebration. If you made this amazing decision to give your life to Jesus today, please stand up so we can CELEBRATE YOU! Let's Celebrate our friends who gave their life to Jesus today! WOOHOO!!

ASK | Encourage children to participate by answering the below questions:

BIBLE TRIVIA

1. What was our memory verse?

(Isaiah 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his



shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.)

2. What was our revelation?

(God delivers His promise)

3. What was our Bible Story about?

(God delivered His promise with Jesus being born in Bethlehem to Mary)

4. Why is it important the way the Jesus was born?

(Because it fulfilled the prophecies of how He would be born, etc...)

5. Did anyone know that baby Jesus was going to be the savior of the world?

(Yes, even the angels said it “a savior has been born who is Christ the Lord”. (anything close to this))

6. Last week we discovered the important of the promises from God that Jesus would fulfill. What was one of the promises or prophecies?

(He would be born in Bethlehem, born of an unmarried woman, line of David, anything that was a prophecy fulfilled.)
