LESSON OVERVIEW

Revelation: Jesus is Alive

Story: Luke 23+24

Heart: Jesus came to Earth and lived a perfect life. He died for us because He loves

us.

Memory Verse: "For God so loved the world, that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." – John 3:16

SUPPLIES NEEDED

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Page Team Lead for all communication of needs (supplies, parent assistance, medical, restroom breaks)
- NEVER leave the classroom without paging Team Lead
- NEVER be alone with a child this includes one on one conversations
- NO pictures or video recording is allowed in the classroom
- Every child and serve team member MUST wear their name tag

DECLARATION

"I am a child of God, full of His Holy Spirit. I am learning His ways. I am made to encounter and connect with Him daily. I am walking in His favor and carrying His presence wherever I go."

CONNECT WITH GOD FOCUS

- Monthly focus provided at the beginning of each month



WORSHIP

TEACHER PROMPT | Encourage the children to enter worship by putting their attention on the goodness of God in their life. Lead them into praise and thanksgiving by modeling it for them. How has God been good to you? What has He provided for you? If it weren't for Him, where would you be? You are a trusted leader, lead the children into the presence of God. THIS MAY BE THE FIRST TIME A CHILD HAS EVER BEEN IN A WORSHIP SETTING, LEAD THEM INTO HOW EASY IT IS.

ACTIVATION | Pray something like this, Holy Spirit, you are welcome here today. We give you the whole room. We invite you into our mind, our thoughts, and our hearts. Move freely in this room and move freely in me! We ask that your presence come in like rain. In Jesus name, Amen."

CLOSE WORSHIP IN PRAYER | Pray something like this: Friends, put your hands out like you're receiving a gift. Pray, "Dear Jesus, thank you for being here. Holy Spirit, teach us to be more like Jesus. Amen."

REVELATION

SAY | Our revelation is JESUS IS ALIVE! Say it with me JESUS IS ALIVE!!

Can anyone tell me what Jesus did that was SO important?! (give time for response) Jesus died to save us from our sins. Our sin is our sad choices and disobedience towards God. Sin is what keeps you away from God, but Father God wants to be close to you. Say "Father God wants to be close to me". Today we will discover Jesus' rescue plan for us so we can be close to Father God. **Our revelation is JESUS IS ALIVE**

Let's pray, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don't make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.



BIBLE STORY

TEACHER PROMPT | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

BIBLE STORY INTRO | Our Bible story today is found in Luke 23+24

The first people that God made were Adam and Eve, they got to live with God and walk with Him. One day they sinned and disobeyed God and were sent out of His presence, but God had a rescue plan. Jesus came to earth as a baby and was completely good. He taught many people about Father God and healed the sick and raised the dead. The rulers and religious leaders didn't like this, and they didn't believe that Jesus was God's son, and they were jealous that some people were calling Him King. They planned to arrest Jesus and get rid of Him once and for all. Jesus was beaten up and they made Him carry a big wooden cross all the way up a hill and once He was to the top the solders nailed Him to the cross. When He died, He took all of our sins so that nothing could separate us from the presence of God. After 3 days He rose from the dead and appeared to His followers and many people and later was taken back up to heaven where He lives now next to Father God.

Jesus chose to die on the cross for us because He was the rescue plan to save us from our sin and now He is alive and has sent us Holy Spirit to be our helper!

Our revelation is JESUS IS ALIVE!

TEACHER PROMPT | Ask Holy Spirit what He wants to do in this next moment and lean in, in leading children in a salvation call. This can look like briefly sharing what Jesus saved you from!

SALVATION + RECAP

TEACHER PROMPT | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!



SAY | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc, have everyone repeat prayer together)

PRAYER | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.

CELEBRATION | At TLC one of our values is Celebration. If you made this amazing decision to give your life to Jesus today, please stand up so we can CELEBRATE YOU! Let's Celebrate our friends who gave their life to Jesus today! WOOHOO!!


