REVELATION

SAY | Your life is made of choices. You make choices every day and every day you partner with something.

What choices have you made today? (Allow for a response)

Every decision you make partners with something and produces something. When you make the choice to brush your teeth, partnership happens with your toothbrush and toothpaste, and fresh breath is produced. This is a silly example, but this is the truth of every choice. As a child of God, you will be invited into making the choice to partner with Holy Spirit and produce things that are impossible for people in their own strength. There is not anything that you can accomplish in our own strength but when you choose to partner with Father God you get to be a part of His plan of bringing Heaven on earth.

ASK | What Bible stories can you think of where someone partnered with God and something impossible to man happened? (Help brainstorm examples)

Today's revelation is, Nothing is Impossible with God

Let's pray, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don't make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.

BIBLE LESSON

TEACHER PROMPT | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

BIBLE LESSON INTRO | Our Bible lesson today is found in Luke 1

Elizabeth in the Bible was married to Zechariah, a priest. Elizabeth was also the cousin of Mary, the mother of Jesus. The Bible describes Elizabeth and her husband, as "righteous and blameless" they obeyed all the Lord's commands. The first time the Bible mentions Elizabeth, she is described as old in age and barren, barren means unable to have children. For years they prayed for a child but did not have one. In their old age, their desire to have a baby seemed impossible.



ASK | Have you been praying for something for a long time? What are you believing God for today? (Allow for a response)

One day, Zechariah had an encounter with an angel, Gabriel, and the favor of God came on Elizabeth. What was an impossibility became a reality.

One day Zechariah's was serving as a priest in God's temple. He was chosen to go into the temple of the Lord to burn incense. An angel of the Lord appeared to Zechariah. When Zechariah saw him, he was amazed and terrified. But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zechariah. "Your prayer has been heard. Your wife Elizabeth will have a child. It will be a boy, and you must call him John. He will be a joy and delight to you. His birth will make many people very glad." And he went on to prophecy what kind of life John would live.

Zechariah asked the angel, "How can I be sure of this? I am an old man, and my wife is old too." The angel said to him, "I am Gabriel. I serve God. I have been sent to speak to you and to tell you this good news. And now you will have to be silent. You will not be able to speak until after John is born. That's because you did not believe my words. They will come true at the time God has chosen."

When he came out of the temple, he could not speak. After this, his wife Elizabeth became pregnant. "The Lord has done this for me," she said. "In these days, he has been kind to me. He has taken away my shame among the people."

Late her cousin Mary came into town and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby inside her jumped. And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. In a loud voice she called out, "God has blessed you more than other women. And blessed is the child you will have! But why is God so kind to me? As soon as I heard the sound of your voice, the baby inside me jumped for joy. You are a woman God has blessed. You have believed that the Lord would keep his promises to you!"

Our revelation today is, Nothing is Impossible with God.



Elizabeth was secure in who she was and what God put inside of her to carry. Elizabeth rejoiced when the Spirit of God told her Mary was pregnant with the Messiah. Elizabeth could have fallen into the trap of comparing herself to Mary and becoming jealous that Mary was chosen to carry Jesus – but she didn't! It's important you do not fall into the trap of comparing what God has placed inside of you to what He has placed inside of someone else. Elizabeth and Mary carried a unique gift on the inside of them. Both carried an assignment that would fulfill the plan of God here on earth and both were significant. The Bible never mentions them getting into competition with each other. The Bible does talk about how they were there for each other as the plan of God was fulfilled.

Today's revelation is, Nothing is Impossible with God

TEACHER PROMPT | Ask Holy Spirit what He wants to do in this next moment.

SALVATION + DISCUSSION

TEACHER PROMPT | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!

SAY | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc. have everyone repeat prayer together)

PRAYER | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.
