



FOUNDATIONS – I OBEY GOD

LESSON OVERVIEW

Revelation: I Obey God

Story: Genesis 7+8

Heart: There is safety in obedience and obedience brings blessing. When we obey, God the Father is happy.

Memory Verse: “Children obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.” – Ephesians 6:1

SUPPLIES NEEDED

Craft Supplies:

- Craft Page
- Markers/Crayons/Colored Pencils

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Page Team Lead for all communication of needs (supplies, parent assistance, medical, restroom breaks)
- NEVER leave the classroom without paging Team Lead
- NEVER be alone with a child – this includes one on one conversations
- NO pictures or video recording is allowed in the classroom
- Every child and serve team member MUST wear their name tag

DECLARATION

“I am a child of God, full of His Holy Spirit. I am learning His ways. I am made to encounter and connect with Him daily. I am walking in His favor and carrying His presence wherever I go.”

CONNECT WITH GOD FOCUS

- Monthly focus provided at the beginning of each month



WORSHIP

TEACHER PROMPT | Encourage the children to enter worship by putting their attention on the goodness of God in their life. Lead them into praise and thanksgiving by modeling it for them. How has God been good to you? What has He provided for you? If it weren't for Him, where would you be? You are a trusted leader, lead the children into the presence of God. **THIS MAY BE THE FIRST TIME A CHILD HAS EVER BEEN IN A WORSHIP SETTING, LEAD THEM INTO HOW EASY IT IS.**

ACTIVATION | Pray something like this, Holy Spirit, you are welcome here today. We give you the whole room. We invite you into our mind, our thoughts, and our hearts. Move freely in this room and move freely in me! We ask that your presence come in like rain. In Jesus name, Amen.”

CLOSE WORSHIP IN PRAYER | Pray something like this: Friends, put your hands out like you're receiving a gift. Pray, “Dear Jesus, thank you for being here. Holy Spirit, teach us to be more like Jesus. Amen.”

REVELATION

SAY | Our revelation is I OBEY GOD! Say it with me I OBEY GOD!

In the Bible, God told His people Israel that if they obeyed Him that things would go well, and they would have a long life! Children, did you know that God wants good things for you? He knows the things that will help us and the things that can hurt us. For us to be safe and have a good life we need to obey Him. God showed us His love by sending Jesus to save us, and we can show God, we love Him by obeying Him. A life of obedience is a life that's full of God's love, protection and peace! **Our revelation is I OBEY GOD**

Let's pray, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don't make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.



BIBLE STORY

TEACHER PROMPT | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

BIBLE STORY INTRO | Our Bible story today is found in Genesis 7+8

ASK | Can anyone tell me about the story of Noah and the ark? Wait for responses. God was sad that all the people were disobeying and making sad choices. He decided that because of all the evil happening in the world, He was going to bring a flood and make it rain for 40 days and nights, to start over with Noah and his family. Imagine that... in the whole entire world there was only one family that loved and obeyed God!

God told Noah about the flood to come and showed him what to do so he and his family would be safe. God gave Noah instructions on how to build the ark and take care of the animals He would bring there. Finally, the rain came, and the world was flooded.

Because Noah obeyed God, Noah and his family were safe. There is safety and blessing when you obey God. It makes the heart of Father God happy when we obey.

Our revelation is I OBEY GOD

TEACHER PROMPT | Ask Holy Spirit what He wants to do in this next moment and lean in, this can look like briefly sharing how obedience brought blessing or safety into your life, or walking into repentance for disobedience.

SALVATION + RECAP

TEACHER PROMPT | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!

SAY | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close



to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc, have everyone repeat prayer together)

PRAYER | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.

CELEBRATION | At TLC one of our values is Celebration. If you made this amazing decision to give your life to Jesus today, please stand up so we can CELEBRATE YOU! Let's Celebrate our friends who gave their life to Jesus today! WOOHOO!!
