



FOUNDATIONS – GOD IS WITH ME

LESSON OVERVIEW

Revelation: God is With Me

Story: 1 Samuel 17 + Daniel 6

Heart: Anytime you feel afraid, you can always remember that God is with you and ask Him for help.

Memory Verse: “Fear not, because I am with you. Do not be afraid, because I am your God.” – Isaiah 41:10

SUPPLIES NEEDED

Craft Supplies:

- Craft Page
- Markers/Crayons/Colored Pencils

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Page Team Lead for all communication of needs (supplies, parent assistance, medical, restroom breaks)
- NEVER leave the classroom without paging Team Lead
- NEVER be alone with a child – this includes one on one conversations
- NO pictures or video recording is allowed in the classroom
- Every child and serve team member MUST wear their name tag

DECLARATION

“I am a child of God, full of His Holy Spirit. I am learning His ways. I am made to encounter and connect with Him daily. I am walking in His favor and carrying His presence wherever I go.”

CONNECT WITH GOD FOCUS

- Monthly focus provided at the beginning of each month



WORSHIP

TEACHER PROMPT | Encourage the children to enter worship by putting their attention on the goodness of God in their life. Lead them into praise and thanksgiving by modeling it for them. How has God been good to you? What has He provided for you? If it weren't for Him, where would you be? You are a trusted leader, lead the children into the presence of God. **THIS MAY BE THE FIRST TIME A CHILD HAS EVER BEEN IN A WORSHIP SETTING, LEAD THEM INTO HOW EASY IT IS.**

ACTIVATION | Pray something like this, Holy Spirit, you are welcome here today. We give you the whole room. We invite you into our mind, our thoughts, and our hearts. Move freely in this room and move freely in me! We ask that your presence come in like rain. In Jesus name, Amen.”

CLOSE WORSHIP IN PRAYER | Pray something like this: Friends, put your hands out like you're receiving a gift. Pray, “Dear Jesus, thank you for being here. Holy Spirit, teach us to be more like Jesus. Amen.”

REVELATION

SAY | Children, did you know that you have a great Helper (Holy Spirit) who is always with you? Can you tell me about a time where God was with you? (pause for responses)

Today we will discover some people who loved God and wanted what He wanted, and God was with them! **Our revelation today is God Is with Me.**

Let's pray, Holy Spirit, we welcome you here, we don't make room for you, but we give you the entire room. We ask you to teach us your ways so that we may know you and find your favor. Speak Lord, your servants are listening. Amen.

BIBLE STORY

TEACHER PROMPT | If you memorize this story and this lesson, it will help you teach it in excellence and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you and through you.

BIBLE STORY INTRO | Our Bible story today is found in 1 Samuel 17 + Daniel 6



A young boy named David was ready to fight a giant named Goliath for his people the Israelites. David had faith in God that He would fight for him because God was on His side. David went to battle with Goliath with only a few stones and a sling, and with his faith, David put a stone in the sling and aimed it at Goliath and when he let it go it hit Goliath in the head, knocking him down, giving David and the Israelites the victory! God was with David! David was a young boy who defeated a giant! It wasn't by his own power, but because God was with him, the impossible was made possible.

There were 3 more young men in our story today who stood up against evil and God was with them. Their names are Shadrack Meshack and Abednego. The king at the time had ordered the entire kingdom to bow down to an idol or a giant statue of himself and if someone didn't, they would be thrown into a fiery furnace. Shadrack Meshack and Abednego knew that pleasing God and not bowing to any idols was the most important thing to do, they wanted to only make God happy. When it was time to bow to the idol, they did not so they were thrown into the fire! But they had faith that Father God would save them, and HE did! God stood with them in the fire! God was with them, the impossible was made possible.

God was with David and with the Hebrew boys because they wanted what God wanted.

Our revelation today is, God Is with Me!

TEACHER PROMPT | Ask Holy Spirit what He wants to do in this next moment. This can look like leading children into a time to ask Holy Spirit to come show them how He has been with them.

SALVATION + RECAP

TEACHER PROMPT | This invitation to an eternity with Jesus is huge! Be sensitive to what Holy Spirit wants to do in this time. Ask Him to think through your thoughts and speak through your mouth!

SAY | God loves YOU so much that He gave his only Son that anyone who believes, in Jesus, might be saved and have everlasting life, John 3:16. God wants to be close



to you. He has taken every step to be close to you. If you have never accepted Jesus into your heart, you can today! (You can invite children to raise hands, come forward, etc, have everyone repeat prayer together)

PRAYER | Father God you are Holy. Holy Spirit, we thank you for all that you teach us and that we get to know you Jesus, we thank you for laying down your life so that we can be close to you. Jesus, would you forgive us from our sins. Would you come live in our heart forever. Amen.

CELEBRATION | At TLC one of our values is Celebration. If you made this amazing decision to give your life to Jesus today, please stand up so we can CELEBRATE YOU! Let's Celebrate our friends who gave their life to Jesus today! WOOHOO!!
