3's Preschool Class

Age Requirements: Age 3 by August 1, 2024

Days: Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday

Times: 9:00 a.m. -11:15 a.m.

Cost: \$1,300.00 paid in ten monthly installments of \$130.00

Requirements: Children must be potty trained. Pull ups are allowed. We understand that young children may have an occasional accident and ask that you send extra clothing in provided school bag.

Description:

This class will focus on colors, shapes, numbers, and introduction to letters. Students learn scissor skills and how to grip a pencil along with prewriting skills. Students learn to follow classroom rules, listening skills, sharing with our friends, using inside voices, clean up after ourselves and restroom/handwashing responsibilities.

This class will have a lesson each day along with Chapel on Thursdays. Students will enjoy play time to encourage social and emotional development.

Pre-Kindergarten Class

Age Requirements: Age 4 by August 1, 2024

Days: Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday

Times: 9:00 a.m. -11:30 a.m.

Cost: \$1,500.00 paid in ten monthly installments of \$150.00

Description:

The goal of the pre-k class is to prepare children for kindergarten. Little Blessings Preschool uses a spiritual, academic, and social curriculum. The curriculum is based each year on the skills the children need in order to be successful in kindergarten. The pre-k class will review basic skills such as colors and shapes. The main educational objective is on number and letter writing, recognition, and application. Children will learn proper letter writing, letter sounds, upper and lower case, and pre-reading with phonics.

Pre-k utilizes a "learning center" concept. Multiple tables are used each day focusing on a developmental objective. Students will visit each center throughout the morning. Children are given time to enjoy free play each day. This is an important time for social and emotional development. Gym time or outdoor play is used daily to encourage movement and fun.

Cost: \$2,000.00 paid in ten monthly installments of \$200.00

The curriculum is based each year on the skills the children need in order to be successful in kindergarten. The pre-k plus class will review basic skills such as colors and shapes. Age Requirements: Ages 3-5

Days: Tuesday and Thursday

Times: 11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

Cost: \$10.00 each time your child stays

You can pay each time your child stays, by the week, or with monthly tuition.

Description:

Lunch Bunch is offered very Tuesday and Thursday until 1:00 p.m. Students in the 3's class or pre-k class may join Lunch Bunch. This is an additional, optional program where students pack a lunch and stay for an extra time of games, crafts, and fun! Lunch Bunch is very popular so early sign up is encouraged.

Students bring a lunch from home and enjoy lunch at school. Teachers will help students learn the routines of eating lunch in a school environment. After lunch, the children will make a seasonal craft, play games, and enjoy gym time or outdoor time on the playground.
