

They were thinking of breaking the vase when the father said, "Now my son, make one more try. Open your hand and hold your fingers out straight as you see me doing and then pull." In Matthew 14, the disciples saw Jesus walking across the top of the Sea of Galilee coming toward their fishing vessel. When he had told them to relax because it was him, Peter told Jesus that if it was truly him, to invite him to walk out to him. Jesus told him to come.
