A message from Ben Cole, Senior Minister

Through this MOVE series, I pray that God has been stirring your heart to take steps of faith, trust His calling, and follow where He leads. Each week has carried a sense of excitement as we have talked about what it looks like to move when God says move. It has been encouraging to see so many of you respond in unity, prayer, and a growing sense of trust in this move with God.

As we continue, we are moving beyond the Red Sea and setting our sights on the Jordan River, a journey that should have taken only two weeks but, for the Israelites, lasted forty years. This Sunday, we will be in Numbers 14, where the focus will be the cost of fear. God had already promised Israel the land, yet fear held their faith captive. What they saw with their eyes from their leaders in Numbers 13 overshadowed the promises God had spoken.

It seems as though every time God calls His people to move, we face that same choice: fear or faith. When we trust His Word more than our worries, we move from hesitation to assurance, from wandering to living in His promises.

In the weeks ahead, we will be in Joshua chapters 1 and 4, where God calls Joshua first to be strong and courageous. He then calls His people to follow Joshua's lead and cross the Jordan River. It is important note about the Jordan River: there is no bridge, and there is no way to cross unless God moves again. Of course, God demonstrates His faithfulness, parting the Jordan, and His people showed their faith as they step forward.

November 16th is Commitment Sunday. This will be our Jordan River moment, a time for all of us to take a step forward in faith. Remember to **bring your stone** so that we will be able to tell generations to come what these stones mean, a reminder of God's faithfulness and our trust in Him. He is not just going to build a building; He is building faith, vision, and community that will impact generations to come.

Let us continue to come each Sunday with open hearts. The same God who led Israel across the Red Sea and the Jordan is leading our church today. I love you all. Your faith encourages me. Let us keep moving forward, being strong and courageous, trusting God has already gone before us.

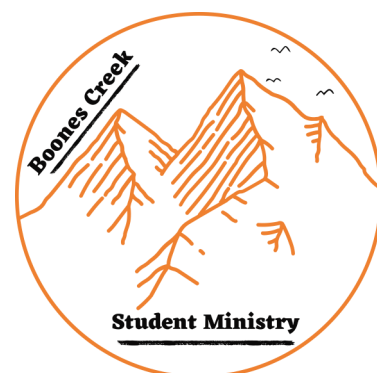
families, please reach out to Brian Snyder as we get this new group some great help to love the kids, but also the parents who endure a lot during this process.

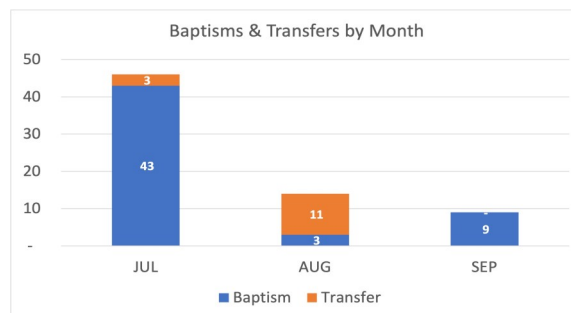
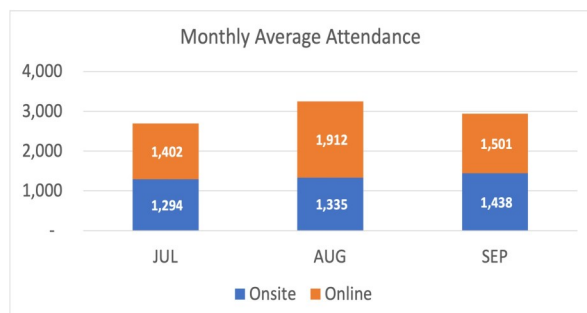
