#### A message from Ben Cole, Senior Minister

For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.....and everybody said

#### AMEN!

Question, did everybody just say amen? I suppose that is dependent on whether you have been in service the last 13 weeks. Because for the last 13 weeks we have been studying through the Word of God in a little five chapter book called James. I do not know about anyone else, but I believe after each sermon I have preached I walked away with one overwhelming thought; I need to change my whole life! I am not trying to be critical of myself, but as always just trying to be real. Listen...

When we started this series

I was not...

- Considering trials joy
- Being quick to listen, slow to speak, slow to become angry
- Looking after widows and orphans in their distress
- Taming my tongue (going to stop there)

#### Good possibility

I was...

- Showing favoritism
- Merely listening to the Word and not doing what it says
- Being a friend of the world
- Living in luxury, self indulgence (again going to stop there)

One word to explain this urgent need to change pretty much everything about how I am living my life for Christ, I said it in the first paragraph, overwhelmed.

Overwhelmed by how far I still have to go.

Overwhelmed by how short life really is.

Overwhelmed by the reality that I have been walking through this life with parts of me that are not aligned with the Word.

So many things to change, in such little time.

Remember, life is a mist.

God how am I going to make so many changes in this mist of life?

Again, overwhelmed.

Then I opened His Word to prepare for the sermon this week and I read...

"Be <u>patient</u>, then, brothers and sisters, until the Lord's coming." James goes on to illustrate patience by using a farmer waiting on the spring and autumn rain. He actually says <u>patiently</u> waiting on the rain. That is verse seven of James chapter five then of course verse 8, "You too, be <u>patient</u> and stand firm." James as he is wrapping up the end of his letter with all this teaching that is difficult for us to flesh out. He uses the word patience three times in two verses.

Do not be overwhelmed with all these changes that you more than likely have been convicted to make in your life. Do not be overwhelmed but INSTEAD be patient and remember this amazing truth,

He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 1:6)

See it is not James giving us the Words of an abundant life in Christ. No, it is God using James as a vessel to give us these Words. By the way God is your Creator, He knows your thoughts, He knows your doubts, He knows your worries and concerns. He knows that He is the One who began the good work and, Praise God, He is the One who will complete it. Let us praise Him today for the conviction, let us praise Him today for the strength He will give us to turn the conviction into comfort as we wait patiently for Him to come back.

This is the day the Lord has made, we will rejoice and be glad in it! Love to you all,

# **Starting Point**



Join us Tuesday, September 9th at 6:30 PM in room 106. Please bring a snack to share and use Entry B when you arrive.








# **Fall Ladies Bible Study**


### Widow2Widow
