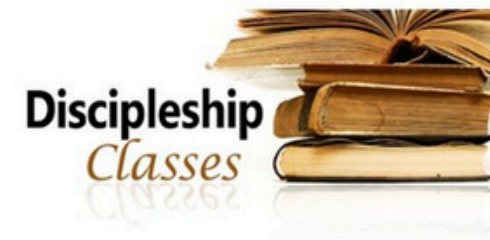
WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDIES
