A Word From Our Pastor

It is not often that I receive a message while preaching a funeral service, but it happened the other day. The Clevenger family and I were listening to "Amazing Grace" being played at Joe's graveside service in Tulsa. I know the hymn by heart. But the Lord spoke to me. There I was listening to the words sung by a familiar singer when the second verse leapt out at me. "Twas grace that taught my heart to fear, and grace my fears relieved." I have sung that verse a thousand times but, on that day, God got my attention.

I read a true-life story of a man who hollered at a boy on a bike that was about to get hit by a fast-moving truck. The man ended up screaming at the boy who stop his bike just in time

to avoid the fast-moving vehicle. The man apologized for screaming at the boy, but the boy's father responded, "No, thank you. You can scream at him anytime you like." The young boy was headed for sure disaster. He needed someone to scream at him. Yes, he needed to be afraid. Did you hear me? He needed to be afraid. He was in extreme danger!

May I remind you of the verse in Proverbs 9:10; "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding." Fear can be a good thing and it has purpose. Now, listen to the line in the hymn again, "Twas grace that taught my heart to fear, and grace my fears relieved." Go back to the boy for a moment. Is the boy still



afraid after the near accident involving the truck? Of course not, he moved to a place of safety and the danger passed, so the fear also passed.

We need to be reminded of the fear of God that is sung about in Amazing Grace. Satan and all his allies are doing everything possible to run us over like the truck bearing down on the boy on the bike. We are in danger from this sin-sick world and our children and grandchildren are targets too. We need that grace to teach us to fear the Lord, and that same grace can relieve our fears once we are in the safety of our Lord's care. The fear of the Lord is the first step into a lifetime of walking in His wisdom. Once we have moved from the place of danger into His protection, there is no longer any need to hang on to that fear. In His sanctuary — under His care — there is assurance and confidence.


