- ~ We will be recognizing the Sunday School classes with the best % of attendance.


A Word From Our Pastor

Over the last couple of years, we have had news reports out of Canada dealing with First Amendment issues concerning some churches in Canada and some pastors being threatened with fines and jail over "hate speech." The hate speech according to Canadian authorities is Scripture verses quoted by Christians dealing with social and moral issues of our day. Evidently, not all speech is protected in Canada. And it is not just confined to our neighbors to the North.

I shared this past Sunday night concerning the two Christian Finnish parliament members who have been charged with hate crimes in the country of Finland. Paivi Rasanen and Lutheran Bishop Juhana Pohjola

have been prosecuted now for three years after Rasanen tweeted a picture of Bible verses in June 2019. Complaints about this tweet led to her prosecution under Finland's "hate crimes" laws. The government investigation has uncovered a pamphlet Rasanen wrote and Pohjola printed concerning Christian teaching about sex being reserved only for marriage and marriage being defined as between one man and one woman. If convicted the government prosecutor is seeking a fine of one third of her yearly salary, destruction of all Christian documents of Rasanen and two years in prison.

What concerns me about what is happening in Canada and Finland is that there are people in this country who share the same views. In fact, a piece of legislation called the "Equality Act" would amend the 1964 Civil Rights Act to include sexual orientation and gender identity in prohibiting discrimination. There is already "hate speech" language



the U.S. House and is stalled in the Senate. The Democratic Party has pushed this bill and it has the support of President Joe Biden. This bill must not become law, or we will be facing the same issues as Christians in Canada and Finland.

The Scripture is clear in Isaiah 5:20 where it says, "Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; Who substitute darkness for light and light for darkness; Who substitute bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter!" This country was founded on principles out of God's Word and yet we have people in this country who want to make the posting of Scripture passages a hate crime!

Hopefully, most of you will agree that we live in a mixed-up world. Satan has been twisting God's Word as long as the Garden. Our country is confused on what is right and what is wrong. We as a nation have rejected God and His Word as our standard years ago. What we have now is chaos. As believers, we must not give in to the "woke" radicals in this country and continue to stand on the truth of God's Word. If not, you might have to visit your pastor in jail one of these days!

THE MISSIONARY TASK (M-TASK)

Dear Church,

We'd like to introduce you to what our organization, the IMB, calls the Missionary Task (M-task) and what we believe the Bible calls ALL Christians to be a part of; it's not just for those who are "missionaries." These pictures and the information below is from a training we do called the Father's Heart and the Field.¹ This month, we're going to start focusing on the Father's Heart.





The Father's Heart is for His glory. Habakkuk 2:14 says "For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea." God's chief desire is for His glory to fill the earth and for all mankind to glorify and honor Him. We often think that the purpose of missions is to save the lost. This is one important reason we do missions. However, it is not the primary reason. The primary reason we do missions is to bring glory and honor to God. The ultimate vision in heaven is for every tribe, tongue, and nation to surround the throne of God giving Him worship and honor (Revelation 7:9). Reaching the lost for Christ, planting churches, and expanding the Kingdom of God across the globe brings

glory to God, so our first point to remember is that **the Father's Heart is for His glory** (symbolized by lines going out from the heart). We'll focus next month on the way the **Father spreads his glory across the world through bringing people to Himself**.
