You have heard the old phrase, "If at first you don't succeed, try, try again." Well, the people in Oklahoma that think we need to legalize recreational marijuana have submitted a proposed initiative to legalize recreational marijuana for adults. If approved, State Question 837 would be voted on sometime in 2026. If approved by the voting citizens of Oklahoma, SQ 837 would amend the state constitution to legalize cannabis for all adults aged 21 and older. Oklahomans have already rejected one state question on recreational marijuana, and it appears we may have to do it again.

We have already experienced the consequences of "medical" marijuana in this state since 2018. It was supposed to stop our medical woes and money woes in this state. But we have illegal grow farms that are being operated by organized crime. People are addicted to smoking this supposedly "medical" marijuana and it is affecting our state. It was sold as a medical treatment, but the state question never said what the "medical" marijuana was good for. As your pastor, I want to jump ahead of this and encourage you to not sign any petitions to get State Question 837 on the ballot. They must have 172,993 signatures from Oklahomans to get it on the ballot sometime in 2026. Please say NO when you are asked to sign one.

If anyone wants to know the impact of recreational marijuana, all you have to do is go to Colorado and see the horrible impact. Traffic deaths are up 138% since legalization, exposure to marijuana increased 185% since legalization of recreational marijuana. Colorado is 3rd in the nation of marijuana use in adults, and college students. The state is 7th in marijuana use for youth 12-17. Also, marijuana tax benefits to the state coffers are on 0.98% of the budget in Colorado.

We have already seen a chilling impact here in Oklahoma on marijuana use, addiction and crime. We have more dispensaries than any other state in the Union. Just now we are beginning to read reports of how marijuana affects long-term memory loss and birth defects of pregnant women. Anyone who claims they have a medical problem can get a doctor somewhere to give them a "medical" marijuana license in this state. Our youth are vaping and smoking more marijuana since SQ was passed in 2018. Innocent people have been poisoned by marijuana being slipped into food or snacks. Please pray and be informed about this very important situation in our state. We need to come together as believers and say "NO" one more time to recreational marijuana. 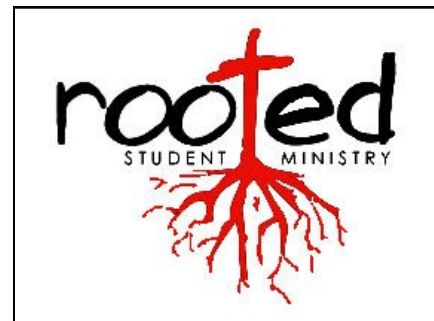
