
Confirmation will resume soon! Currently we are coordinating with our class members and their families to determine the best way to finish out our class which was interrupted by COVID.

FUN & FELLOWSHIP





MISSIONS

One of GLPC's mission partners his Presbyterian Children's Homes and Services. Read on to find out more about this wonderful organization!



OUR WORK:

Presbyterian Children's Homes and Services' (PCHAS) provides Christ-centered care and support to children and families in need since 1903. Our mission is to provide care and support for children and families in need. In the Houston area, we do this through a few different programs: Foster Care and Adoption, Single Parent Family housing, Maternity Services, and our Child and Family program.

We are a faith-based Christian organization which strives to serve like Jesus. We meet our clients where they are and treat them with respect. We focus on our clients' strengths rather than their problems. And we encourage our clients to focus on their future rather than their past. When we do this well, we help children and families find hope and know the love of God.

Our philosophy of care is family centered, strength focused and goal driven.

RESPONSE TO COVID-19:

2020 has been difficult on so many, not least the children and families we serve through this program. The pandemic is causing many families to struggle and really suffer. They are facing job loss, lack of child care, food insecurity and much more. PCHAS has had to think of creative solutions to keep supporting families and children during this time. A few different ways we have responded to the pandemic has been:

- 1) We have increased our outreach funds so that as families have critical needs, such as food, rent and utility assistance or devices for virtually learning.
- 2) Our Child and Family specialists have switched to telehealth for their regular counseling Despite the disruption caused by COVID-19, children who received tutoring from PCHAS increased their reading skills by over 20% and their math skills by over 26%.
- 3) Our Foster Care and Adoption staff are using Telehealth, masks and other personal protective equipment as well as socially distancing when in person visits are needed.

Rather than pulling back, we hope to increase our level of support to children and families who are feeling incredibly vulnerable at this time.

GET INVOLVED:

Due to the current health crisis, we are currently not conducting any face to face volunteer opportunities. However, PCHAS has opportunities such as back to school time and the holiday seasons to be involved. We offer the opportunity to help with collection drives for tangible items, yielding opportunities to sponsor children and/or help collect and organize these goods. With faithful support from individuals, churches and foundations, we serve 4,500 children and families across three states every year. As stewards of this trust and support, we follow these tenets of excellence to ensure adults achieve self-sufficiency and children are placed into loving, permanent homes.


