




Celebrating Pentecost

Following our Springtime observances of Lent, Palm Sunday, Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and Easter, we celebrate worship on May 23 with the Day of Pentecost—one of the most important events in Christianity. It was on about the fiftieth day after the Resurrection, and ten days after his ascension, that Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to dwell in us and bestow the gifts of faith, holiness, and eternal life.

According to Acts 2:33, Peter said to the crowd, "Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he (Jesus) has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing." The Holy Spirit entered into everyone who was there from all areas around the Mediterranean including Jews, proselytes, Cretans and Arabians. (They

had come together to celebrate The Festival of Weeks, also known as Pentecost.)

The indwelling of the Holy Spirit is a recurring theme in the New Testament. Paul stated it clearly in Romans 8:9, "You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to Him."


Women's Thursday Bible Study

Romans Bible Study







FINANCE & STEWARDSHIP

1st Quarter Financial Update

As we shared with the congregation at our 2021 Congregational Meeting, the church is going to have a tight budget this year. This is due in no small part to the COVID-19 pandemic and the impact it is having on all our lives. We are now through the first quarter of the year, and we are happy to report that giving is holding strong. The church has brought in about 34% of our total offering budget for the year leaving us slightly ahead of the curve. We are also managing expenses extremely well.

Note that we are entering the warmer months of the year which typically lead to higher expenses since we are running the air conditioners a lot more. Thanks to all the support from our members, the church is in a good financial position entering these summer months. This is allowing us to evaluate several deferred maintenance projects to ensure that our HVAC systems are well equipped to keep us all cool this summer.

In summary, the church is healthy, but please continue to do what you can to meet your pledge commitments. The coming months will be a great opportunity for GLPC to reinvigorate ourselves and maintain our focus on celebrating the grace and glory of God!
