Christian De la Cruz just completed his 12th year of teaching as the associate choir director with the internationally acclaimed Reagan High School Choir Program and has served as the associate director of music at First Protestant Church since 2014. Christian graduated Summa Cum Laude from Texas State University with a bachelors in music education and a minor in mathematics thanks to the Terry Foundation Full Ride Scholarship awarded to just 16 out of over 5000 incoming freshmen. Choirs under his direction have earned consistent Superior ratings at UIL, and Reagan Choir has consistently had multiple students earn a spot in the Texas All-State Choirs. In 2017 Reagan placed first in the Texas Madrigal Festival. Christian is frequently invited as a clinician, judge, and quest conductor throughout the state. Christian has conducted and sung with choirs in Peru, South Africa, the UK, Switzerland, and Italy. In 2019 the Reagan Choir program won the Leonardo Da Vinci International Choral Festival in Florence, Italy where they competed against choirs from Spain, Denmark, Bulgaria, the Philippines, Indonesia, Costa Rica, and China. Christian is excited for his new calling in Katy, TX where he will be moving this summer with his two greatest joys: his wife, Audrey, and seven year old daughter, Rose. Christian is excited to be the new Interim Director of Music at Grand Lakes Presbyterian Church and the new head choir director at Tompkins High School.

Men's Friday Bible Study


