

Getting To Know Our New Pastor!

On Sunday, March 20th, our congregation voted to call Rev. Tyler Henderson to serve as the next pastor of GLPC! Tyler has been with GLPC for the last four years serving as our Associate Pastor for Youth and Family Ministry. While we have had the opportunity to get to know Tyler and his family over the last four years, we thought we would ask him a few questions about things you may not know about him and his family.



I attended college at Midwestern State University in my hometown of Wichita Falls,
 TX. After a change of major nearly mid-way through college, I graduated with a
 Bachelor of Science in Geology... I can't say I use it too much nowadays!

What all jobs have you had prior to GLPC?

- The day I turned 16 my parents handed me the keys to a hand-me-down truck and said, "It's got a full tank of gas... if you want another one, you better go find a job." With that, I spent the rest of that day picking up applications! Throughout high school I worked at a local Ace Hardware store (many things I learned there have stayed with me and been very useful to me in homeownership!). I have also worked as a civilian on an Air Force base and at a Christian summer camp. Throughout college I worked as a youth intern for my home church. After college I worked for 4 years as a Geologist for the state of Texas before filling the position as the Youth Director of First Presbyterian Church of Wichita Falls.

Where did you go to seminary and what was the best part of it?

- I attended Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary. Living in the Austin area was a lot of fun and has some great food! As a break from coursework, I thought I would also complete a bucket list goal by training and completing my first marathon.

Pentecost - Birth of the Church

On Sunday, June 5, we will celebrate Pentecost and begin a new season of the church year. Each Sunday will be designated by ordinal numbers—1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc. after Pentecost—all the way to Advent. So, Pentecost is very important in the history of the church.

In the Jewish tradition Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after Passover. The Jews celebrated both God's giving of grain for food and the law. All Jewish men were required to be in Jerusalem for that event. It was during that event that the Apostles were together and received the

Holy Spirit. According to Acts 2: "And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them

ability." This enabled the others present to understand the Apostles' teaching and led to the birth of the church. On that day about 3000 became Christians.

In our Christian faith, we celebrate Pentecost on the 7th Sunday after Easter. The gift of the Holy Spirit to each of us enables our lives of faith. We wear red to remember the tongues like fire. So, Happy Birthday Blessed Church on June 5th!


Summer Colorado Trip June 13th - 17th
