Adore Him

It's the start of a new church year! Our Gregorian Calendar is coming to an end in less than 60 days (yep, 60 days); however, the first Sunday in Advent is the start of the Christian year.

Advent - Advent is a season of anticipating the celebration of the coming of Christ. There are four Sundays in Advent. Each has a specific theme to reflect on the true meaning of Christmas. The first Sunday, November 27, we will reflect on Hope, and God's promise. The three following three Sundays, we will reflect on Peace, Joy, and Love. The first two Sundays look forward to Christ's second coming, and the

second two Sundays look backward to remember Christ's first coming. We have a unique opportunity for families and children to participate in the special time of focusing on the themes during worship.

Epiphany - Christmas marks the incarnation of God in the person of Jesus Christ. Following Christmas, we will celebrate God's manifestation to the world as Jesus Christ on Epiphany Sunday. Epiphany celebrates Christ's appearance in the midst of humanity. Following Epiphany, we will celebrate the baptism of the Christ by John the Baptist and remember our own baptisms. The time after Epiphany lasts for 6 weeks up until Transfiguration Sunday.

Transfiguration Sunday - Transfiguration Sunday is the last Sunday before Ash Wednesday and the Lent.

We hope that you will join us as we begin the new church year, prepare to celebrate the birth of our Lord and Savior, and celebrate His baptism and transfiguration!

Fridays at noon. We read aloud and discuss books by renowned theologians along with pertinent Bible passages, always from a Reformed perspective.




