Worship

"Come and See!"

In John 1:35-51, we see John's account of Jesus' first disciples. It begins with John the Baptist announcing to Andrew and another unnamed disciples (probably John), "Look the Lamb of God!" when Jesus passed by. John the Baptist made a public confession of faith, pointed them to Jesus, and they followed him. Likewise, after Andrew encountered Jesus he found his brother Simon Peter saying to him, "We have found the Messiah!", and he brought Peter to meet Jesus. Then the text describes how Jesus encountered Philip and Jesus called Philip to follow him. Philip, then, found Nathanael saying to him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote - Jesus of Nazareth... Come and see." Nathaniel, even though we see that he had his initial doubts and cynicism encountered Jesus for himself and confessed, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the King of Israel."

Throughout each of these encounters we see how these first disciples come to make a public profession of their faith in Jesus as they commit to follow him, and it also compelled them to invite others to experience Jesus for themselves. Friends, that should still be our motivation. As we encounter Jesus, profess our faith in him, and follow him in our lives, we ought to be compelled to extend the invitation to others to "come and see!" Believe the good news! Jesus is Lord! Jesus is the Son of God! He is the King of kings! Jesus is the living water, the bread of life, the light of life, the resurrection, the vine, the gate, the good shepherd... Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life! God has redeemed us by the Lamb of God who came to take away the sins of the world. In Christ we are rescued, forgiven, and set free. All glory be to God! We invite you, dear reader, to "come and see". As a church, let us continue to pray for opportunities to point others to Jesus and to invite them to "come and see!"

Art Fellowship Thursdays, 10am - 1pm (Come and go as you like)



Here is a quick snapshot on some of the things we did as a congregation in 2022:

KATY CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES (KCM)



GLPC FACILITIES

The facility and Grounds Team's mission is to provide a safe, attractive and fully functional facility and grounds to service the GLPC members and our community partners. In 2022, we had a number of projects that we accomplished such as:

- Installed 24/7/365 real-time cameras
- Contracted Katy Constable for Sunday Service
- Front entry camera and electronic unlocking system
- Repaired and replaced rotted wood, damaged hardy boards, recalled and painted all non-brick siding
- Maintained flower beds and seasonal color plants
- Doubled the internet speed to support on-line services
- Began migration from current lights to LED

We believe that God has provided us with the ways and means to provide an extension of the church's mission to our members and community partners. If the use of our grounds and facility can provide a way to prevent at least one young person from getting into trouble then it more than all of our volunteers sweat equity, time and money is well spent.

FINANCE & STEWARDSHIP

2022 Financial Recap: Overall, 2022 finished off well. Our income was slightly less than budget, but so were our expenses leaving us with a net income of \$16,843. We have maintained level position in our cash reserves, ahead of our 6 months of operating expense target. We invested in property repairs, technology upgrades, and facility security, and Mission funding.

Envisioning 2023: We do face some challenges, but challenges that we feel are manageable. As we were expecting from the slowing economy this fall, our average pledge dollars are down. We have also had a few pledging members move away which reduced our total number of 2023 pledges. In addition, our expenses are going up. One significant area of increase is the interest payments on our loans which are set to reset mid-year which will increase our obligation by \$25,000 for 6 months (meaning that 2024 and beyond will be an increase of \$50,000). We are however looking into other options in an effort to reduce that

figure. The Session has approved a deficit budget for 2023 of \$51,126. On top of this, we still have to calculate our loan principle payments which amount to another \$60,000. The goal is to end 2023 on track with budget while also maintaining our target of 6 months of operating cash. The church is not facing a dire financial crisis, has a comfortable cash reserve, has an experienced and dedicated finance committee and Session, and is well positioned for growth in both spirit and involvement.
