I absolutely love our Christmas Eve Candlelight services. It's the service I most look forward to throughout the year - which I suspect it is for many. Aside from singing Silent Night as candlelight fills the sanctuary with a heartwarming glow, one of my favorite parts of the service is singing the final hymn, "Joy to the World". You probably know the words by heart:

"Joy to the World! The Lord is come; Let earth receive her King. Let every heart prepare Him room, And heav'n and nature sing, And heav'n and nature sing, And heav'n and heav'n and nature sing!"

First published in 1719, this wonderful hymn was written by the famous English minister and hymn writer, Isaac Watts. In writing this hymn, Watts was inspired by Psalm 98. What you may find interesting is that Watts did not write it as a Christmas hymn. If you read the words of the hymn, nowhere does it mention anything of Jesus' birth. What Watts had in mind was an anticipation of Christ's second coming when King Jesus returns in glory.

However, I do not want that to dissuade you from singing it during the Christmas season, for the season of Advent is a season where we both look back with joy at Jesus' first coming while we also look forward with hope to Jesus' second coming. As the words of the hymn describe, consider the blessed image of all heaven and nature singing praise to our King!

This Advent season I hope you will sing with joy and hope as we celebrate together Jesus our Lord and Savior.


YOUTH




MISSIONS

RECAP: GLPC Mission Sunday!!


Mission Sunday 2023 was a huge success, and the Mission Team wants to thank everyone who was able to participate in the projects and to those that volunteered to be the project lead. At least 82

volunteers gave their time to support six different mission projects that helped six different organizations: Citizens for Animal Protection (CAP), Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA), Katy Christian Ministries (KCM), Presbyterian Children's Home (PCHAS) and Roosevelt Alexander Elementary. In addition to these organizations, countless individuals were shown appreciation and thanks through Acts of Kindness. Thanks to Fun & Fellowship for coordinating the meals.



Acts of Kindness

13 volunteers went out into the community to recognize First Responders and Willow Fork Alzheimer's Special Care Center. Also, countless individuals were handed cash to help pay for necessities, groceries and/or lunch. Volunteers handed the below card referencing Peter 4:10-11: As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another...





Roosevelt Alexander Elementary

Approximately 25 volunteers put together 'Thank You' bags for all 135 staff at Alexander. The bags contained apples, caramel cups, corn snack puffs, gum, pretzels and handwritten 'Thank You' cards. The bags were delivered that afternoon, and the staff was very appreciative.

Cat & Dog Toys

Bonnie and Jessica and a handful of the kids made much needed cat and dog toys. The CAP volunteers were very thankful for the toys.





Katy Christian Ministry: Resale Store

Approximately 28 volunteers drove to the KCM resale store in Kingsland Blvd and helped clean floors and windows, straighten shelves, dress mannequins, organize clothes and toys, restock shelves etc... KCM was beyond excited about the hard work this team put in as the very next day, donors were given a tour of the resale store and presented KCM with a check.





Presbyterian Children's Homes & Services Single Parent Family Facility

16 volunteers drove down to the PCHAS duplex complex which is comprised of four sets of duplexes where single parents and children live as they help transform their own lives. The team planted new bushes, mulched, power washed and performed some other cleanup tasks. And just like KCM, our timing was perfect as donors visited the duplexes the following day.

Sewing Projects

Approximately 16 volunteers sewed pillowcases and stockings which the benefactors will be CASA and PCHAS. Prior to this event, the sewing group sewed 50 Christmas stockings of which 30 will be filled with goodies for the KCM and PCHAS toy drives and the remaining 20 will be given to CASA.



KCM DONATION DAY!!

After worship on Sunday, Nov. 5th, our church went to HEB to purchase food and goods for Katy Christian Ministries' Food Pantry. We collected an incredible 1,416 lbs of food and goods!

Many of us were also able to interact with a number of workers and shoppers to share what we were doing and even some of them joined in our donations!



How are we doing?

In spite of what seemed to be an uphill road at the beginning of 2023, our congregation is on track to be well in balance by the end of this year. Much of this balancing of the budget can be attributed to not only the membership heeding the call to fulfill our obligation to care for our church financially, but also to the refinancing of the building and property loans. Additionally Grand Lakes received two grants that allowed us to reimagine some underutilized space within our building as well as upgrade or replace some of our audio-visual equipment. In the meantime, the finance committee is keeping a constant vigil over caring for the needs of our worship space with an eye on potential future capital projects as our facilities continue to age.


Commitment Sunday was November 12th. It was an important day in our church's yearly calendar where we recommit ourselves (individually and corporately) to the Lord.

It is understood that making a pledge to financially support our Church is an expression of our Faith. This year we have decided to take a different approach to stewardship. Rather than conduct our campaign to see what we

have to work with when it is over, we instead are taking a vision-forward approach to let you know that we have set a goal for 2024.

We have diligently worked through what we feel it will take to fund all that we wish to do here at Grand Lakes Pres. We have set a pledge goal of \$550,000 that needs to be reached in order to do all of the things we have planned for this coming year. We feel strongly and positively about where the church is headed and have great expectations. Between the pledges and other income that finds its way to us throughout the year, we feel like we can address all four of the important pillars of our church: Worship, Discipleship, Fellowship, & Mission.

Lastly, a BIG THANK YOU to JIM THOMPSON who has once again given generously of his time to spearhead our stewardship campaign. What a blessing!
