"Come Grow With Us"

In the Protestant church, we often shy away from anything that sounds too much like Roman Catholic tradition. It was that notion of tradition that Martin Luther and others were protesting against. However, as abrupt as it may sound (especially for a brief newsletter article), I want to consider one of the "seven deadly sins" from the Roman Catholic tradition for its universal teaching: the sin of sloth.

The sin of sloth is primarily not about physical laziness; at its core is the idea of spiritual idleness. As counterintuitive as it may seem, busyness can be a form of sloth. I would even go as far as to say that it is the greatest form of sloth plaguing the church today. Someone can indeed be a very busy individual (far from what one may accuse of being slothful), but if that busyness interferes or distracts one from actively growing in their faith then it falls into the category of sloth. One Britannica article says it this way: "Unlike mere laziness, the sin of sloth conveys a willful refusal of the joy that comes from God's love and even repels divine goodness."

Simply put, as Christians we are called to grow. Following Christ is never supposed to be stagnate. No matter our age, location, situation in life... we are called to grow spiritually in Christ. This describes what sanctification is all about - it is a process of becoming more like Jesus. The only way we truly grow is by allowing the Spirit of Christ to transform us from the inside out (John 15:5). Living in the Spirit grows the fruit of holiness (Gal. 5:22-25).

My prayer, not only for myself, but for our church, is that we will never cease to grow in the grace, knowledge, and love of Christ. Will you come grow with us??



September 13-15th




