I am looking forward to continuing our study in the Book of Acts this summer! Acts is an important book for a number of reasons, but perhaps of most interest is it narratively shows how following Jesus has radical implications not only for our inner personal lives, but also our public lives in the communities in which we live.

One of my favorite lines in all of Acts occurs in Acts 17 when Paul and his ministry partner, Silas, go to Thessalonica. As was Paul's normal practice, he went to the synagogue and began to expound the Scriptures and how they in fact point to Jesus - saying emphatically, "This Jesus, whom I proclaim to you, is the Christ!" At this, some of the Jews as well as devout Greeks and some of the leading women were persuaded and believed.

The scene then turns dramatic when some of the Jews were angered by all of this. They formed a mob and went to the house where Paul and Silas were staying, but when they could not find them, the mob seized the homeowner, Jason, and dragged him before the city authorities. They shouted their accusation: "These men who have turned the world upside down have come here also..."

Their accusation was not wrong. Though the gospel that Paul was preaching was not calling for an overthrow of the Roman Empire, it did call for believers to claim a higher allegiance to Christ. It called believers to claim their citizenship with Kingdom of God. It called believers to live in community under a new system of values. The gospel does, in fact, turn our world upside down. This summer, we will be studying the spread of the gospel throughout the ancient Greco-Roman world while also considering how the gospel calls us to live into the Kingdom of God here and now. The Cultivators


