One of my favorite Christmas movies is "Elf" (I imagine that is true for many; it's so good!). There is one line in the movie in which Buddy the Elf says,

"The best way to spread Christmas cheer, is singing loud for all to hear." Like you, I love so many of the Christmas hymns. While it is difficult to name a favorite, for me, "O Come, All Ye Faithful" is high on the list. It is one of my favorites because it brings to mind our Christmas Eve candlelight service. This is usually the very first hymn we sing in the service because the hymn itself serves as a call to worship with its first verse:

"O come, all ye faithful, joyful and triumphant,
O come ye, O come ye to Bethlehem.
Come and behold Him, born the King of angels!
O come, let us adore Him, O come, let us adore Him!
O come, let us adore Him, Christ the Lord!"

Even as I read these words, I can almost feel the warmth of our community gathered in our sanctuary on Christmas Eve night singing in harmony the melodic words of this hymn. Reflecting on the words themselves, they are an invitation for all to come in joyful, reverent celebration of Christ our Lord.

Ultimately, we are to extend this invitation to those around us every day of the year through our words and actions. So, may our lives be living examples of what it means to truly adore Christ (not adoring as in the kind of "aww that's cute" way, but in its fullest definition which is to "love and respect deeply").

I hope that your life will "sing loud" for all to hear... for as Buddy the Elf reminds us, that is the best way to spread Christmas cheer. "O Come, let us adore Him, Christ the Lord!"


Christmas Poinsettias



Childcare is available.





Our church budget works very much the same way – we take the pledged "seed" gifts of time, talent, and treasure and work to cultivate a nourishing church so that we may carry out God's Great Commandment. WE are the church. We plant the seeds for our growth. We depend on each other to cultivate our Christian lives at GLPC.

Last year we came very close to our commitment goal of \$550,000 in pledges to cover our anticipated needs. Thanks to your continued generosity we are 75% through the fiscal year and expect to meet all commitments. It is near harvest time, and the cycle continues. In the coming months we will prayerfully set our 2025 budget goal and start planting our seeds once more. Our work is not done - Keep growing with us!

Lastly, I want to express my gratitude to Jim Thompson who has overseen our stewardship campaigns for as many years as I can remember. He has decided to step down as chairman this year, opening the position for new leadership. Stay tuned. Thank you, Jim!
