"A Season of Thanksgiving"

As far as holidays go, Christmas reigns supreme. And for good reason - what better event to celebrate but the birth of our Lord and Savior? It also takes the top spot in the secular sense as well. If we are honest, most of the excitement of the Christmas season is the decorations around town, the festive songs on the radio, the warm glow in our homes from the lights on our Christmas trees, the movies, the presents... the list goes on and on. Thanksgiving is an important holiday, but in more recent years, it feels like the Thanksgiving holiday gets treated like a speed bump to Christmas season. As soon as Thanksgiving leftovers are put away our Christmas trees go up and Black Friday shopping begins!

In our worship services through the month of November we have been focusing on the importance of giving thanks. We are discussing how we can grow in our thanksgiving through: 1) Acknowledging what God has done - praising the Father our Creator, the Son our Redeemer, the Spirit our Sustainer; 2) Participating in what God is doing through stewardship and service; and 3) Trusting in what God will do.

For us, Thanksgiving ought to be more than merely "Turkey Day". Thanksgiving is to be the posture of our heart toward God. So, may our thoughts and prayers be like that of the Psalmist who praised God:

Psalm 136:1-3, 26

- ¹ Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever.
 - ² Give thanks to the God of gods, for his steadfast love endures forever.
 - ³ Give thanks to the Lord of lords, for his steadfast love endures forever...
 - ²⁶ Give thanks to the God of heaven, for his steadfast love endures forever.

Giving thanks requires us to slow down... so before we jump too quickly into the Christmas season, let us give thanks with sincere hearts to God - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit! Thanks be to God!




