POSITION OVERVIEW

The Maintenance Technician, in collaboration with Houston Northwest Church (HNW) leadership and staff, is responsible for overseeing and supporting the day-to-day maintenance operations of our campus.

This is a part-time role, approved for 28 hours, Monday through Thursday.

To be successful in this role, the Maintenance Technician will uphold the mission, vision, and values of HNW while also working to maintain our facilities and property to aid in our mission to make Houston more like Heaven by helping Houstonians become more like Jesus.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Troubleshoot and perform general maintenance tasks on HVAC systems, roofing, plumbing, electrical, and other facility systems and equipment
- Responsible for regularly walking the campus to proactively identify maintenance needs to ensure all building systems, equipment, and facilities are inspected, serviced quickly, and operating efficiently
- Operate tractors, drive utility vehicles, and hook up/haul trailers as needed
- Maintain equipment and work areas to ensure safety, cleanliness, and efficiency
- Monitor and report on maintenance needs and prioritize urgent repairs
- Communicate effectively with team members and leadership across departments
- Collaborate with vendors and contractors as needed
- Ability to occasionally answer after-hours calls for maintenance emergencies on Sunday mornings (e.g. HVAC, electrical)

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Working knowledge of HVAC systems, roofing, irrigation, painting, electrical, and general building maintenance
- Ability to take initiative and comfortable working independently without constant supervision
- Physically able to perform maintenance tasks, lift heavy items, climb ladders, and operate machinery
- Experience hooking up trailers and operating tractors or utility vehicles
- Previous maintenance experience. Supervisory or lead experience preferred but not required
- Valid driver's license with a clean driving record
- Knowledge of basic safety and compliance standards (OSHA, etc.) preferred
