

Prayers That God Doesn't Answer!

The series title is 'When You Pray' because God assumes we are going to pray but we can't assume He answers every prayer. Did you know that there are Prayers That God Won't Answer? Well... that's what we are looking at today.

When you pray, don't babble on and on as the Gentiles do. They think their prayers are answered merely by repeating their words again and again. Matthew 6:7

God doesn't answer the babbling, religious prayer.

God Doesn't Answer <u>RELIGIOUS</u> Prayers

Then Jesus told this story to some who had great confidence in **their own righteousness** and scorned everyone else: Luke 18:9

Religion is confidence in my own ability to be right with God.

Two men went to the Temple to pray. One was a Pharisee, and the other was a despised tax collector. The Pharisee stood by himself and prayed this prayer: 'I thank you, God, that I am not like other people—cheaters, sinners, adulterers. I'm certainly not like that tax collector!' Luke 18:10-11

Thank you I'm not as bad as some sinners. I've never slept around. You think that He has to answer your prayer, you're wrong.

"But the tax collector stood at a distance and dared not even lift his eyes to heaven as he prayed. Instead, he beat his chest in sorrow, saying, 'O God, be merciful to me, for I am a sinner.' ¹⁴ I tell you, this sinner, not the Pharisee, returned home justified before God. For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted." Luke 18:13-14

Religion brings pride, humility brings righteousness.

Pride goes before destruction, and haughtiness before a fall. Proverbs 16:18

If we can't have faith in our own religion, what then?

But when you ask Him, be sure that your faith is in God alone. Do not waver, for a person with divided loyalty is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind. ⁷ Such people should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. James 1:6-7

Why? Because you're divided between two kingdoms.

God Doesn't Answer <u>DOUBTING</u> Prayers

It is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to Him must believe that **God exists** <u>and</u> that **He rewards those who sincerely seek Him**. Hebrews 11:6

You must first believe God exists and He will reward you.

The spirit often throws him into the fire or into water, trying to kill him. Have mercy on us and help us, if you can." "What do you mean, 'If I can'?" Jesus asked. "Anything is possible if a person believes." ²⁴ The father instantly cried out, "I do believe, but help me overcome my unbelief!" Mark 9:22-24

This is an honest prayer.

Sometimes God Answers NO

Paul Said...

I have received such wonderful revelations from God. So to keep me from becoming proud, I was given a thorn in my flesh, a messenger from Satan to torment me and keep me from becoming proud. Three different times I begged the Lord to take it away. 2 Corinthians 12:7-8

Each time He said, "My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness." So now I am glad to boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ can work through me. 2 Corinthians 12:8-9

Paul had an issue and begged the Lord but the Lord said NO!

And even when you ask, you don't get it because **your motives** are all wrong—you want only what will give you pleasure. James 4:3

God Doesn't Answer <u>HEATHEN</u> Prayers

A heathen in the Bible, is one who does not acknowledge God.

Pray no more for these people, Jeremiah. Do not weep or pray for them, and don't beg me to help them, for I will not listen to you. Jeremiah 7:16

They worship the queen of heaven, they have idols. I won't listen.

We know that God doesn't listen to sinners, but He is ready to hear those who worship Him **and** do His will. John 9:31

The Lord is far from the wicked, but He hears the prayers of the righteous. Proverbs 15:29

What makes us right with God? Repentance. Not Religion.
