Isaiah looked forward with expectation that God would do a miracle. That the Messiah would show up and set the captives free, break the yoke of oppression, and bring hope into the world. He prophesied this verse.

Let all that I am wait quietly before God, for my hope is in Him. Psalm 62:5

#### Expect them to say YES!

#### **Deck the Halls with CELEBRATION**

After this interview, the wise men went their way. And the star they had seen in the east guided them to Bethlehem. It went ahead of them and stopped over the place where the child was. <sup>10</sup> When they saw the star, they were filled with joy! <sup>11</sup> They entered the house and saw the child with His mother, Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped Him. Matthew 2:9-11a **Get people to come to the house where Jesus is.**
