



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Scriptures

- Revelation 19-21

Opening Questions

- When you look at our world today, what forms of “evil” feel most in-your-face?
- How does Revelation’s imagery of Jesus as a Warrior challenge or encourage your view of Him?

On Scenes I–III (The Warrior, the Victory Feast, Satan Chained) Rev. 19:11-17

- What stands out to you about Jesus’ appearance and role in Revelation 19?
- How does the idea of evil becoming “bird food” help you frame the temporary power of wicked systems?
- What does John’s symbolic meaning of the “1,000 years” reveal about God’s sovereignty over evil?

On Scenes IV–V (Martyrs Reigning, Satan’s Brief Release)

- What comfort do you find in John’s description of martyred believers reigning with Christ?
- Why do you think God allows Satan to be released “for a little while”?
- How does the instant defeat of evil reshape your understanding of the so-called “final battle”?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS, CONT.

On Scene VI (Final Judgment)

- What do the two sets of books—book of deeds and book of life—teach us about grace and accountability?
- How does the idea that “what we do on earth is noticed in heaven” challenge your daily living?

On Scene VII (New Heaven and New Earth)

- Which part of Revelation 21:1–5 most deeply touches your heart and why?
- How does the promise “I am making everything new” speak to areas of your life that still need healing?

Live it Out

- What “beasts” or “false prophets” (cultural idols, beliefs, or systems) tempt you most often?
- How can we cultivate a lifestyle that aligns us clearly with Jesus’ victory instead of the world’s values?
- How does the fact that there is no final battle (because the battle is already won) change how you engage with spiritual attacks even now?
- Revelation ends with a question: Will you choose to follow Jesus or not? How would you answer that today, and what would it look like practically this week? (KEY: Following and believing in are not the same thing. Following is actively responding to Jesus’ warnings in Revelation.)

Prayer

- Praise God for His final victory over evil.
- Ask for discernment to resist false powers in our world.
- Pray for endurance in spiritual battles and hope in God’s restoration.
