Job 34-35 - "Finding A Way Out"

Psalms 99:9 - God asks so little. One thing asked of us is to worship Him alone. What can be challenges to Worship Him without hesitation?

Share a recent example of your worship to Him being of a holy nature.

I Thessalonians 4:7 – This verse teaches that God's Holiness is something we are called to. What are some examples of things that seem to be holy to the Lord, but can at times have hidden motives. (examples: Could serving Him ever look like that? What about giving? Prayer?) Discuss: Is being called to a "holiness" something we've made more complicated than God intended ... or have we possibly cheapened it?

Hebrews 12:14 - How is the simple example of unity in the body of Christ a witness of God's Holiness in His people? Does the world offer anything close to this? What is holy to the world? How does it differ from the Holiness of God?
