As a pastor, I have found ministry to be a unique and beautiful journey—sprinkled with everyday challenges. We live in an ever-changing world. Seasons change, people change, and even the smallest details of life change. Just yesterday, we were moving from carburetors to fuel injection, and now cars can practically drive themselves. Previous generations would have said much of what we experience today was impossible.

Some of these changes are exciting and beneficial, while others are deeper, more transformative, and sometimes more difficult. Cities change. Beloved restaurants and stores close, while new ones open. Families change. Babies grow up and lose their sweet little accents, becoming articulate young adults with strong opinions. Loved ones we cherish go on to spend eternity with Jesus. Children grow up and leave the nest. Even family schedules shift with each season of life.

As a parent, I sometimes feel daunted by the pace of change and wonder how my children will navigate the future. Will they thrive? Will the things we cherish endure? In these moments, I realize how often fear and preference can win out over faith. Reflecting on this has helped me see our church's own changing nature more clearly—and to appreciate its beauty as well as its struggles.

Our church is changing. At FBC, it feels like we've walked through a whirlwind of transitions in just a few years. I want to reassure you—that is okay. Our styles, methods, programs, service times, technology, and even how we carry the gospel to the nations may change. And that is okay. We cannot let fear, the unknown, or our personal preferences fuel discontent. Instead, we must ask the Lord to awaken fresh faith, pour fresh oil upon our heads, and light the fire of His Spirit within our hearts.

But this we know: the gospel will never change. That is where our hope lies. Our building can change, our staff can change, our styles can change—but the good news of Jesus Christ remains forever. If we cling to the gospel with everything we have, we will be more than okay. We will be the kind of church Jesus describes in Revelation—centered on our first love, devoted to our King, and desperate to see the gospel transform our city—the kind of church Jesus desires.

As your pastor, I want you to hear my heart. I am laying everything on the altar so that any might be saved. I am unafraid of discomfort if it grows the kingdom, and criticism has lost its sting. The gospel is all that matters. Until it matters most, we will always be distracted by things that change. So let us cling together to the Rock of our salvation—the unchanging, precious Christ.

The Bible reminds us in Hebrews 13:8: "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever."

So cling with me to the message of hope that shatters darkness, breaks chains, and heals the broken. Cling with me to the unwavering power of Christ, and let us lay everything else on the altar as an offering of prayer:

My Prayer Is Simple:

Jesus, change our style if it saves a soul. Change our structure if it brings them home. Change the method if it makes one whole. Change our time and take control. Loosen my grip and help me grow. Change my mind to think like You. Change my heart to be made new. Change it all—or leave it be. Reign it tight or set it free. Whatever idol You find in my hand, pry it loose while You can. Make Your Word my first delight, Your heart, Your will my one desire. Jesus, You can have my church— After all. You died to make it Yours.
